Professional Personnel

Resignations

Professional staff may resign at any time with consent of the Board. No professional staff may resign during the school term in order to accept another similar position without the consent of the Board. Professional staff may resign outside of a school term if the staff member provides written notice to the secretary of the Board, at least 30 calendar days prior to the first student attendance day of the following school year. Professional staff who resign with less than 30 days' notice prior to the first student attendance day of the following school term will be deemed to have resigned during the school term.
