

# Natoma Station Hug N' Go Guidelines

The safety of our Natoma Station students, teachers, and families is of utmost importance. Let's take care of one another by following these guidelines in the Hug N' Go Lane.

## Please Do

### Slow Down

Keep your speed under 5 mph while driving in the lane.



### Be Aware

Drop off & pick up times get hectic. Yield to pedestrians in crosswalks!



### Pull Forward

Pull all the way forward to close the gap between cars. Keep moving forward as cars exit.



### Exit on the Right

Have your child exit on the passenger side of your vehicle. This keeps them safer and allows better traffic flow.



### Use your Signals

Let other drivers know your intentions by using your turn signals to get in and out of the lanes.



### Be Courteous

Courtesy is contagious! Extend kindness to NSE staff, fellow drivers, pedestrians.



## Please Don't

### Use cell Phones



Using phones while driving makes us 23% more likely to be involved in an accident.

### Drive Aggressively

Hostile driving shortens reaction time, making it harder to be cautious in a busy situation.



### Idle Your Engine

When at all possible, turn off your engine while waiting for your student(s). Help protect kids from harmful emissions.



### Get out of your Vehicle

Doing so blocks and slows down traffic as well as putting yourself at risk of injury.



### Stop Directly in Front of the Main Entrance

Not even in bad weather. This blocks incoming traffic and school buses.



### Park in the Hug N' Go Lane

This includes Preschool and half-day Kindergarten.
