Continuation of Services During Local District Work Stoppage

In the event of a strike by its employees, a local district may continue to send students to SEDOL programs. If a SEDOL program is located in a building declared closed by the local Member District, SEDOL will cooperate with the local district in attempts to locate an alternative facility. In the event no suitable alternative facility can be located, SEDOL may suspend the program until an alternative facility may be found and may reassign SEDOL staff serving the local program to alternative duties.

The Member District incurring the work stoppage shall be held responsible for any additional expenses resulting from the work stoppage. (i.e., extension of the work year, transportation).
