Fact

Homeless & foster youth have disproportionately low graduation rates compared to their peers with stable housing. Research indicates that our vulnerable youth face numerous challenges, including unstable living arrangements, lack of access to resources & support, & higher rates of trauma. As a result, many struggle to stay in school & complete their education, making the transition to adulthood even more challenging.

Efforts to provide targeted support & resources for homeless and foster youth during this critical period can significantly improve their chances of graduating & achieving future success.



Celebrating Graduates

Each year, the SIT Program awards scholarships to homeless and foster youth across our District. This year, we were able to grant \$7,000 to one deserving student.
