DO NOT RESUSCITATE DNR SCHOOL TRANSPORTATION RESPONSE PLAN

A Do Not Resuscitate Order is a physician's directive that cardiopulmonary resuscitation not be used in the event of a cardiac or respiratory arrest. This includes breathing and ventilation by any assistive or mechanical means, chest compressions, defibrillation, or other related life sustaining procedures.
A DNR order is separate from other aspects of the student's care.

A copy of the original State of Illinois Do Not Resuscitate Order is completed and attached.

In the event of a medical emergency during transportation, the following steps will be taken once the bus driver has pulled over and stopped the bus.

1. Bus driver to call dispatch/transportation office to request EMS services.
2. Bus dispatch to call parent/guardian and give location.
3. Bus dispatch to call school and give location.
4. School principal/designee to notify SEDOL nurse, SEDOL nursing coordinator, and SEDOL administration.
5. Upon arrival, bus driver to alert EMS that the student has a DNR order and produce documentation.
6. Bus driver to ask additional EMS staff or police personnel who may respond to remain on the scene as long as necessary to provide help with the needs of other students and staff.
