Camp Location: Parkway Elementary, 11745 FM 1488 Magnolia, 77354

Before and After Camp Hours: 6:30 – 9:00 a.m. / 4:00 – 6:30 p.m.

Camp Hours: 9:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.

Shuttle Location: Magnolia Elementary, 31900 Nichols Sawmill Rd. Magnolia, 77355 - campers will be bussed to and from Parkway Elementary.

Drop-off between 6:30 a.m. – 8:30 a.m.

Pick-up between 4:30 p.m. – 6:30 p.m.

Dates of Camp: June 3 - July 26, 2024

The first day of the 2024 - 25 school year for Magnolia ISD is Thursday, August 8th. CAMP ENDS ON FRIDAY, JULY 26th, which is 8 days before the first day of school. This will allow adequate preparation for the start of the new school year.

Camp Holidays & Closures:

Thursday and Friday, July 4th and 5th in observance of the 4th of July Holiday. MISD Adventures Program will also be closed during the Professional Development Days, August 1st through 7th.

Drop-off & Pick-up

- **Parkway Elementary** - At the CAFETERIA in the back of the campus. Drop off is from 6:30 am-9:00 am. Pick up is from 3:30-6:30 pm - **Phone: 832-580-0891**
- **Magnolia Elementary (SHUTTLE BUS):** - At the CAFETERIA off of Commerce Street from 6:30am-8:30am. The shuttle bus departs at 8:30 am. Pick up is from 4:30-6:30 pm - **Phone: 832-963-1113**
- **Pick-Up:** Please call in advance any time you are on the way to pick up your camper so we may have them ready. Please make sure you have your ID available.
- **Authorized Pick-up:** If you call to give authorization for someone not listed on the pick-up list, we must also receive written notification in advance, preferably via email. If we are unable to verify a person's authorization through the above defined process, we will not release the camper.

- Please note - The first day of school for Magnolia ISD is Thursday, August 8th. CAMP ENDS ON FRIDAY, JULY 26TH, which is 8 days before the first day of the 2024-25 school year for MISD. This will allow our staff preparation time to be ready for the first day of the new school year.

Water & Swim/Pool Days

- Water Day & Swimming Pool locations are dependent upon the age of the campers:
 - **5-6 Year Olds** - Weekly **Water Day** activities, including inflatable water slides. This age group will remain at camp on these days.
 - **7-8 Year Olds** - Weekly **Swimming Pool**. This age group will be bussed to Candy Cane Pool & Park, located at 1205 Candy Cane Ln, Conroe, TX 77301 and is operated by the City of Conroe: <https://www.cityofconroe.org/departments/parks-recreation/facilities-centers/conroe-aquatic-center>. This age group will be measured by height for clearance on water slides.
 - **9 Year Olds** - Weekly **Swimming Pool**. This age group will be bussed to Alden Bridge Pool, located at 7725 Alden Bridge Dr, The Woodlands, TX 77382 and operated by The Woodlands Township Community Pools: <https://www.thewoodlandstownship-tx.gov/322/Community-Pools>. Swim Tests for this age group will be conducted prior to swimming each pool day. If a camper fails the swim test, they will be instructed to stay in the shallow end with a yellow wristband on for identification.
 - **10-12 Year Olds** - Weekly **Swimming Pool**. This age group will be bussed to Harper's Landing Pool, located at 2 Blair Bridge Dr, The Woodlands, TX 77385 and is operated by The Woodlands Township. For information regarding The Woodlands Township Community Pools and guidelines, please visit <https://www.thewoodlandstownship-tx.gov/322/Community-Pools>. Swim Tests for this age group will be conducted prior to swimming each pool day.
- Campers should wear their swimsuits to camp and bring a towel, change of clothes and waterproof sunscreen. Sandals/flip-flops are optional and will be allowed on water & swim days only. No athletic shorts, undergarments or cutoffs are allowed in the pool.
- **Please label all items with your camper's name.**
- **PLEASE NOTE: Pool locations are subject to change. Parents will be notified should pool locations change.**

What to Bring

PLEASE LABEL everything your camper brings to camp. All of the below items should be kept in your camper's individual bag or backpack.

- ✓ Refillable water bottle/container (water fountains are accessible throughout the campus)
- ✓ **MORNING SNACK & LUNCH (Daily)** ...unless there is a special event in which parents will be notified
- ✓ Sunscreen (SPF 30 or higher, waterproof)
- ✓ Wear appropriate clothing (refer to the school District Student Handbook)
- ✓ Close-toed shoes (tennis shoes, etc.)
- ✓ Extra change of clothes (there will be "messy" days and activities)
- ✓ Swim Days: towel, sunscreen, change of clothes

***An afternoon snack will be provided to each camper.**

What NOT to Bring

Please do not send personal toys, games, money, or other items of high monetary value with the campers. During special occasions (such as "show and tell" days) parents will be notified. Adventures Program staff will not be responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged items.

Electronics

At certain times, campers may be allowed to utilize their electronics. It is at the discretion of the parent/guardian whether your camper may bring them, as alternative activities will be provided. Cell phones **MUST** be kept in your camper's backpack. Adventures Program staff will not be responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged electronics.

Camp Safety

Emergency Preparedness

The safety of the campers and staff is of the highest priority in Magnolia ISD and Magnolia ISD programs. Each of the MISD campuses has a comprehensive Crisis Handbook that addresses emergency situations. The Adventures staff is familiar with the plan for their location.

Health and Well-Being

Safety and well-being are a priority for the Adventures Program. All reasonable and necessary precautionary measures will be taken. Campers should be able to participate comfortably in the summer camp activities. If a camper cannot participate, parents need to notify the Adventures staff accordingly. Although the Adventures Program does not maintain an on-site school nurse or other health professional, the Adventures staff is trained in basic first aid, CPR, and procedures for handling accidents and incidents.

- Parents who have campers with medication needs must complete an ***Authorization for Dispensing Medication*** form. Forms may be obtained through the Adventures Program. The delivery of medication, the maintenance of medication, and the dispensing of medication will follow the same guidelines outlined in the Magnolia ISD Student Handbook.

- The Adventures Program does not provide extra clothes on site. Campers should have an extra set of play clothes to help with accidents of any type; and if necessary, the change of clothes could help your camper's situation immediately.
- Please refer to the Magnolia ISD Student Handbook for information regarding Accident Insurance and Emergency Medical Treatment. For specific questions, please contact the Adventures Program administration.
- Per the Texas Health Department, immunization records are required for each camper to participate in the summer camp program, even if records were previously provided to a MISD Campus. Immunizations can be scanned to adventuresprogram@magnoliaisd.org or faxed to 281-356-1328.

The Adventures Summer Camp Program is licensed through the Texas Department of State Health Services. It is associated with Magnolia ISD and is operated by MISD employees.

Behavior Guidelines

The MISD Summer Camp Adventures strives to maintain a staff-to-camper ratio of 1:10. If a camper requires a lesser ratio, this program may not be best suited for the camper. In order to provide all campers and staff with a safe and enjoyable experience at camp, we adhere to the following disciplinary guidelines.

1. Camper will be redirected to a more appropriate behavior and expectation
2. If an inappropriate behavior continues, the camper will be provided with a consequence (ie. time-out based on age, sitting out from gym/pool time, etc.)
3. If a camper's behavior still does not improve and is affecting the experience of other campers, he/she will be referred to one of the Camp Site Managers
4. If inappropriate behavior continues, as a final action step, the camper may be suspended or terminated from camp

Parents may be notified depending upon severity of the incident and/or to discuss further action. Camper fees are non-refundable if a camper is sent home for disciplinary reasons.

If a camper is terminated from summer camp, they will not be eligible to attend any programs until the following calendar year.

Camper Behavior Expectations

- We respect ourselves, other campers, and staff
- We use respectful and appropriate language
- We use appropriate voice levels inside and outside
- We respect school/camp property and equipment
- We are responsible for our belongings and do not take what belongs to others
- We participate in activities, follow instructions, and cooperate with staff
- We ask permission before leaving the group
- We respect Safety Guidelines (on the bus, on a field trip, on the playground, etc.)
- We have FUN!!

Rates and Payment Information

*Reduced Rate applies to MISD employees or those eligible for Free / Reduced Lunch

Registration Fee: A non-refundable and non-transferable Annual Registration Fee of \$40 (or \$30 Reduced*) will be charged per camper upon enrollment into this year's Adventures Summer Camp.

Tuition Rates

Weekly: Regular \$160.00 / *Reduced \$120.00

July 1 - 3 (no Field Trip): Regular \$130.00 / *Reduced \$98.00
Rounded 10% sibling discount

No Drop-In: There is no Drop-In option for Summer Camp.

Payment Options: It is the expectation that payment will be made in advance of attendance as follows:

- Auto-Draft/Recurring Billing Cycles: Weekly, drafted each Tuesday prior to the camp week
- Payment through our billing software system, Enrolls with ACH Draft / Credit / Debit Card

Payment Deadline: Weekly tuition is due on Monday, the week prior to Camp. Auto-draft will be scheduled on Tuesdays, the week prior to Camp starting. If payment has not been received by the end of day Tuesday prior to Camp starting, the Camper will not be included in the next week's attendance roster and will not be allowed to attend the following week.

No Late Registration: Space is limited for Summer Camp and **there will not be an option for late registration.** Enrollment is scheduled by the week and a waitlist will be available if capacity has been reached for each week.

Withdrawals and Refunds: If a parent wishes to cancel enrollment for any week that a camper is enrolled in the Adventures 2024 Summer Camp, a written notice must be provided by email to: adventuresprogram@magnoliaisd.org and must be received no later than the Tuesday prior to the week of camp. Credits / refunds may take up to 30 days to be processed.
