

## Welcome to the Santa Fe High School Art Department

Please look for the course you have enrolled in below for the required supplies you need throughout the school year. We will provide basic class sets of specific items, however these will be up to you to have and maintain through the year. Most of these items can be found at Walmart, Amazon, or Hobby Lobby.

### Art 1 Students' - Required Supply List

- Facial tissues
- Colored pencils (12 count or more)
- Broad tip colored marker set (12 count or more)
- Scissors
- 4 Glue sticks
- Sketchbook (50 pages- multi-media to include wet surfaces)
- 1 pack assorted color construction paper
- 24 #2 pencils
- 4+ erasers
- Pencil sharpener
- 12" ruler
- Black permanent marker (2 minimum- fine tips are good to have)
- One durable supply bag or plastic box big enough to keep all these supplies

### Art 2 Students' Personal Supply List (suggested)

#### Pastel Supply List:

- Pastel paper (optional)
- Plastic box to store pastels
- 1-2 kneaded rubber eraser
- 2 vinyl erasers
- Soft pastels- personal set
- Oil pastels- personal set
- Tortillions and/or blending stumps
- Soft paintbrush (or soft makeup brush- can be an old one)
- Facial tissues
- Small travel box of Q-tips
- Sketchbook (25-50 pages)
- One durable supply bag or plastic box big enough to keep all these supplies

#### Ceramics Supply List

- Apron (optional purchase- we have a class set but if you want your own you can buy one)
- Small spray bottle for water
- Ceramic brushes
- Pottery Tools- (Hobby Lobby- \$5.99 and up, and on Amazon)
- Plastic pencil box or bag to store supplies
- Facial tissues
- Sketchbook (25-50 pages)
- One durable supply bag or plastic box big enough to keep all these supplies
