## Phil Loadholt Star Athlete Award



*Phil Loadholt was a stellar athlete – in high school he received All-State recognition in three sports – football, basketball, and track and field. He earned a scholarship to Oklahoma University as an offensive lineman on the Sooner football team followed by a 7-year career with the Minnesota Vikings of the NFL. Phil Loadholt fostered his love of athletics and inspired his peers at Carson Middle School. This award will recognize the most prolific 8<sup>th</sup> grade male and female competitors at Carson Middle School*

### **General Induction Candidacy Requirements:**

---

1. Must demonstrate excellent character and sportsmanship in competitions.
2. Must stand out among teammates in both excellence in performance and commitment in practice.
3. Student-Athletes are only considered for distinction as 8<sup>th</sup> graders.
4. Must be nominated (in-writing) by at least one head coach based on their excellence in athletics.
5. Must stand out among peers in one or more CMS sports as the stand-out athlete.
6. Must meet school attendance, behavior, and eligibility standards.

### **Additional Qualifications**

---

1. Individual/team league champion
2. Team Award Winner
3. School record holder or season statistical holder
4. Recognition by opponents for excellence in competition

**\*Sport must be offered at CMS.**

### **Process:**

---

1. Athletes are nominated by their head coach.
2. Nominations are taken to the Athletes of Distinction Board for review.
3. Board considers all nominations and votes for which candidates are inducted (75% vote approval needed).
4. Only one male and one female athlete to be considered per head coach.
5. All student athletes will be notified of their nomination.
6. One male and one female student-athlete (8<sup>th</sup> grade only) will receive the Phil Loadholt Star Athlete Award.
7. Award winners' picture and short biography will be displayed at CMS for five years.



## Ascending Eagle Superior Student-Athlete Award



*The Ascending Eagle Superior Student-Athlete Award is to recognize the top female and the top male as the most comprehensive member of one or more CMS sports programs. This student exemplifies excellence in competition, scholastic achievement, and citizenship to the community of Carson Middle School. This 8<sup>th</sup> grader shines wherever she/he represents Eagle Nation.*

### **General Requirements:**

---

1. Must demonstrate strong character, leadership, and exemplary academic performance.
2. Student-Athletes are only considered for distinction as 8<sup>th</sup> graders.
3. Must consistently compete and perform as a member of at least one A-team.
4. Must be nominated (in-writing) by at least one head coach based on their excellence in athletic performance while demonstrating consistent and distinguished academic records.

### **Additional Qualifications:**

---

1. Prior academic distinctions (Principals Scholar Award, A/B Honor Roll, etc.)
2. Recognition of academic performance (Art Show placement, STEM award, etc.)
3. School record holder or season records
4. FLIGHT Crew
5. Letter of nomination by a CMS teacher

**\*Sport must be offered at Carson Middle School.**

### **Process:**

---

1. Athletes are nominated by their head coach.
2. Nominations are taken to the Athletes of Distinction Board for review.
3. Board considers all nominations and votes for which candidates are inducted (75% vote approval needed).
4. Only one student athlete to be considered per one head coach.
5. All student athletes will be notified of their nomination.
6. One male and one female will receive the Ascending Eagle Superior Student Athlete Award
7. Award winners' picture and short biography will be displayed at CMS for five years.
