

REPLACING DAMAGED or LOST RESOURCES – HIGH SCHOOL

Educational materials may be used at school or be sent home with your learner for additional practice. If these items are lost or damaged, the district may assess a replacement cost. This list provides guidance regarding those costs.

- iPad - \$300
- iPad Case - \$40
- Charging Brick - \$20
- Charging Cable - \$20
- Textbooks - \$80
- Workbooks - \$50
- Logitech Crayon - \$50
- iPad Keyboard - \$50
- Library Books – Actual Cost (check other policies)
- Classroom Books - \$15 (literature and nonfiction)
- Classroom Manipulatives and Tools - \$12
- Other items - Replacement cost TBD*

All learners receive an iPad device at no cost:

- A \$25 fee is assessed for the first incident if accidental damage occurs
- A \$75 fee is assessed for the second incident if accidental damage occurs

*Damaged personal items of staff or learners may also be assessed a replacement fee if deemed appropriate by building administration.
