Primary School Visits

Staff from The Hastings Academy will visit your child at their primary school. We use feedback from the primary school, SATs and assessment results to plan our curriculum and classes.

Planning the Curriculum and Teaching Groups

We will send an electronic form to ask you to identify three friends and a language (French or Spanish) to study. This does not guarantee that your child will be in a class with their friends, but does help us to plan our groupings.

You and your child are invited to a meeting on **Tuesday 25th June 2024** between 4:30-7pm. We will send you an appointment time. This will give you the opportunity to meet key pastoral and leadership staff.

Y6 Transition days

We are excited to welcome your child to our transition days on **Monday 1st and Tuesday 2nd July 2024**. These will run from 8.50am-3.00pm. Children should wear their primary school uniform, and bring a bottle of water and some trainers for outdoor activities. A free lunch will be provided.

Additional Transition Visits

We can arrange extra visits for parents and students who may need extra help at The Hastings Academy. This may include meeting our SENCOs (Special Educational Needs Co-ordinators), attendance and safeguarding teams.

Summer School 2024

Between **Tuesday 27th August- Friday 30th August 2024** 8.50am-3.00pm we will be holding our summer school. We will be working alongside PlaySport UK to run this summer school, which is a great chance for your child to get used to school life by taking part in activities and lessons and meeting their new classmates. Summer school is completely free and will be first-come first-serve. Students will be able to wear their own clothes but are asked to bring a packed lunch and a bottle of water each day.
