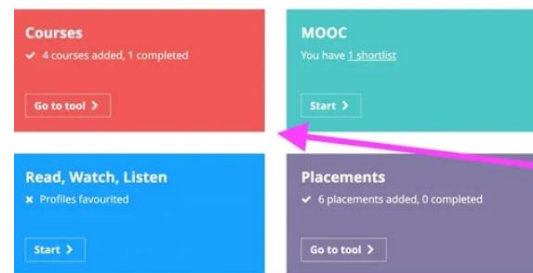
Y10 – Y13 Business Virtual Work Experience, 29 May 10am – 3.30pm

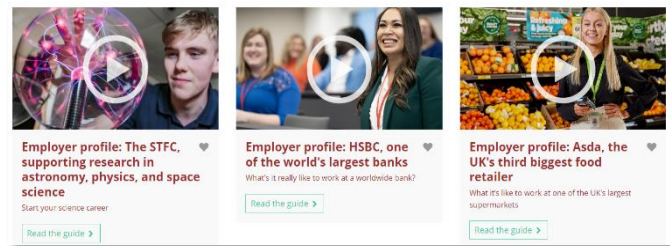
Y7 – Y13 NEW! Courses tool on Unifrog
