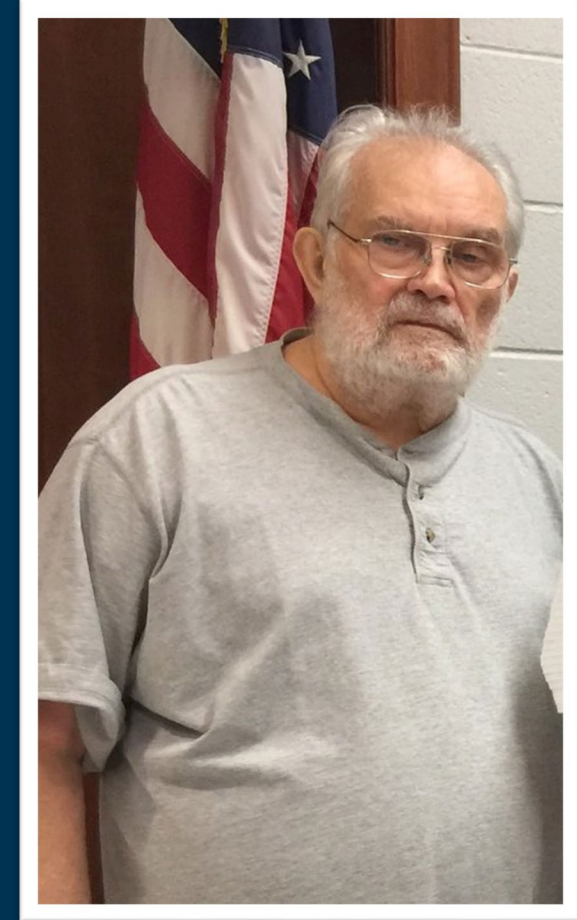
Jim Ross Memorial Award
