- Include information about this in weekly e-news on a monthly basis , along with links that families can use to apply
- Have a sports specific registration discussion during 8th grade curriculum night prior to students enrolling for 9th grade
- Have coaches talk about financial assistance opportunities during their pre-season meetings, discussing that finances should never be a barrier to student being able to participate
- During open registration periods, have emails sent from the athletic director including information and links for families to apply to financial assistance.
- Beginning of the year, have a training specific for assistant principals and counselors as they are often the first in line when families share they need financial assistance
- Re-send communications to families following the initial weeks of the school year.
- Regular ASB membership check and offer to sell to students who make purchases at the bookkeeper's window throughout the school year.
- Multiple informational fairs/opportunities for parents and students to learn about programs and engage with coaches throughout the school year.
