The Emmett School District holds three Child Find Screenings per school year.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

The ECSE Preschool is a Federally funded program designed for children ages 3-5 with developmental delays and/or disabilities. Children must qualify to receive services through standardized assessments with scores at or below the 7th percentile in two or more areas or one area indicating a significant delay compared to typically developing same age peers.

INDIVIDUAL EDUCATION PROGRAM (IEP)

Once determined eligible, an IEP is developed to help students bridge developmental gaps. Placement is determined based on individual student need.
