SOFTBALL: All 10 Lady Cavalier seniors earned Academic All-District honors and final season statistics show that All-District Hitter of the Year Lynden Cole compiled video game numbers as the 2024 Crockett campaign came to its conclusion with a District 13-AAA Tournament elimination last week.

The 10 seniors – Cole, Destiny Foster, Makenna Tibbs, Jayden Maddox, Kinleigh Lamb, Brooklyn Haynes, Karly Pigue, Lesley Morales, Gracelyn Miller, and Maddie Humphrey – made a unique clean sweep in the academic category. In addition to Cole's Hitter of the Year award, sophomore Anna Stallings was named District Pitcher of the Year.

Cole and Maddox were selected to the All-District Tournament team, and Lamb, Haynes, Foster, and Piper White joined Cole and Stallings as All-District honorees.

Crockett's final 2024 season statistics show that Cole's Hitter of the Year award was especially accurate. The senior catcher, bound for Pensacola State College in the fall, batted .465 with 11 home runs and 54 runs batted in over the Lady Cavs' 33-game schedule. Cole had on-base percentage of .547 and an OPS (on-base + slugging percentage) of an other-worldly 1.476, as 24 of her 46 hits went for extra bases.

Stallings posted a 16-10 record and a stellar 1.98 earned run average over more than 140 innings this season. She struck out 114 batters while walking just 40.

Other standout stats for the Lady Cavs were the .417 batting averages compiled by Lamb and White and the fact that Lamb began the season with more than 70 plate appearances before striking out for the first time.
