DECISIONS



. A decision must be made:

A. **Capital Levy** to buy more time for property evaluation and community input – Steve brought this idea forward with the Board and a Capital Levy is NOT on the table at this point.

B. One Campus:

- Build one campus on existing Heights site (\$\$)
 - 24 acres, some new construction, and some remodel. Keep the PreK-5, 1,000 students.
- Build one elementary on new property (\$\$\$\$)
 - 20 acres, 1,000 student capacity when complete
 - Contingency plan what happens if the new property falls through?

C. Two Campuses:

- K-5 both equal size (\$\$) current cost modeling
- Change grade configuration K-2, 3-5 or some variation thereof. (\$ \$\$)



LAND ACQUISITION



If the committee recommends that you build on two sites, the District needs to have a viable site and move through the vetting process prior to a bond resolution.

If this does not happen, the District will need to have a firm contingency plan in place.
