**1. OPENING AND MINUTES**

At 12:00pm District Clerk-Suzanne Nicholson announced that the polls were open for the annual budget vote and election. There were 189 residents who personally votes and 13 absentee ballots were received. The polls closed at 8:00pm and the results were verified.

**Proposition 1- School Budget Vote**

Resolved that, the Board of Education of the Romulus Central School District, Seneca County, is hereby authorized to expend a total of \$12,894,389 for the operation of the school of said District for the school year 2024-2025 and that said sum be raised by tax upon taxable property of said School District after first deducting the estimated money available from State Aide and other sources.

**156 Yes / 45 No (PASSED)**

**Proposition 2- School Bus Purchase**

Be it Resolved that the Board of Education of the Romulus Central School District authorized the withdrawal from the Capital Reserve Fund-Purchase of Buses a sim of money not to exceed two hundred and ten thousand dollars (\$210,000) for the purchase of one (1) 72-passanger school diesel bus for the transportation of District students, said amount to be expending in the 2024-2025 school year.

**170 Yes / 31 No (PASSED)**

**Proposition 3- Ovid Library Levy**

Resolved, that pursuant to Education Law, Section 259, the Board of Education of the Romulus Central School District is authorized to levy and collect an annual tax, year after year, separate and apart from the annual school district budget, in the amount of \$580, I addition to the current appropriation of \$29,000 for a total of \$29,580 annually, which should be paid over for the support and maintenance of the Edith B. Ford Memorial Library.

**141 Yes / 59 No (PASSED)**

**School Board Elections Results- 3 seats available:**

**Linda B. Mastellar – 129 votes (Elected to a 3-year term)**

**Tenneille Brewer- 102 votes (Re-Elected to a 3-year term)**

Caroline Hamelin and Alicia Rath were tied with 76 votes each. This will require a run-off election to be held within the month. The school's legal counsel has been contacted for this election requirement and procedures. Date and time of election to be announced.
