Teacher/Student/Parent Electronic Communications

It is the policy of the Westerly School Committee to facilitate parental involvement in their children's education by enabling parents to engage with teachers, students and school activities electronically. Therefore, it is the policy of the School Committee that all teachers check and respond to parental emails daily and maintain a webpage to provide parents with up to date information on class activities, topics of instruction, homework assignments and the like.

The Westerly School Committee will maintain up to date grade books on the student information system in order to provide parents with access to their children's progress, with each teacher responsible for posting these grades and for engaging with parents in timely manner by use of other software systems specified by Westerly Public Schools for that purpose.
