GROUP PIANO SUMMER RETREAT AGES 16 AND OLDER | JUNE 17 - AUGUST 8, 2024

Group Piano Summer Retreat is a one- to three-week program for aspiring musicians ages 16 and older. Learn how to play piano in a stress-free group atmosphere. This course is spread over three weeks advancing in level – join all three or just one!

PRIVATE LESSONS

Private lessons allow each student to develop independently through the careful guidance and mentorship of expert, credentialed faculty. We offer private lessons in woodwind, brass and string instruments, keyboard, percussion, voice, as well as composition, music theory, and piano tuning.
