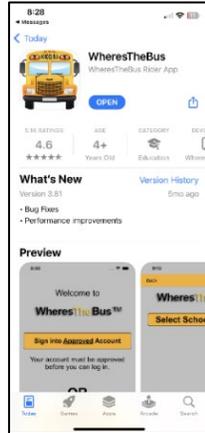


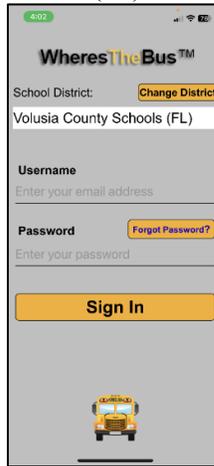
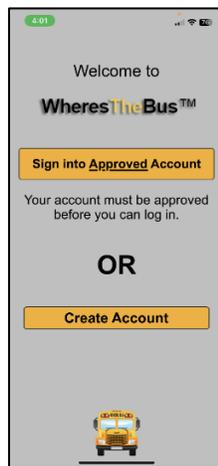

iOS and Android app installation

1. Open the App store or Goggle play store. Tap on the magnifying glass icon and search for the WheresTheBus app. Install it and open it.



2. If you're signing into an existing account, tap on “**Sign into Approved Account**”.
 - a. Select "Volusia County Schools (FL)", enter your username and password, and tap "**Sign In**".

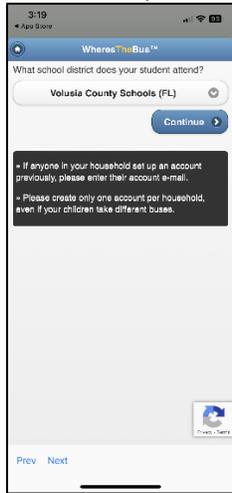


3. If you do not have an account, tap on “**Create Account**”.

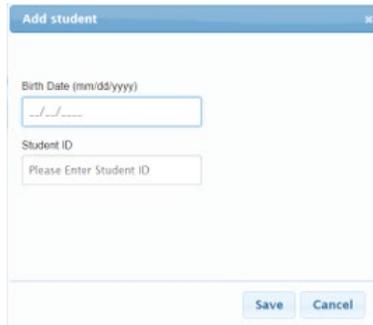
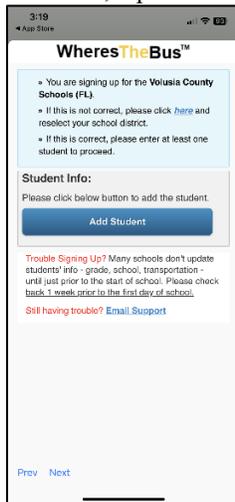

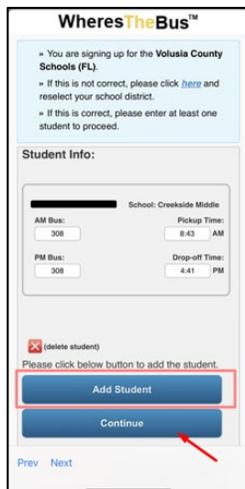
4. Select "Volusia County Schools (FL)" and tap "Continue".

6. Verify that the student's route is correct. If you've added all students, tap "Continue".

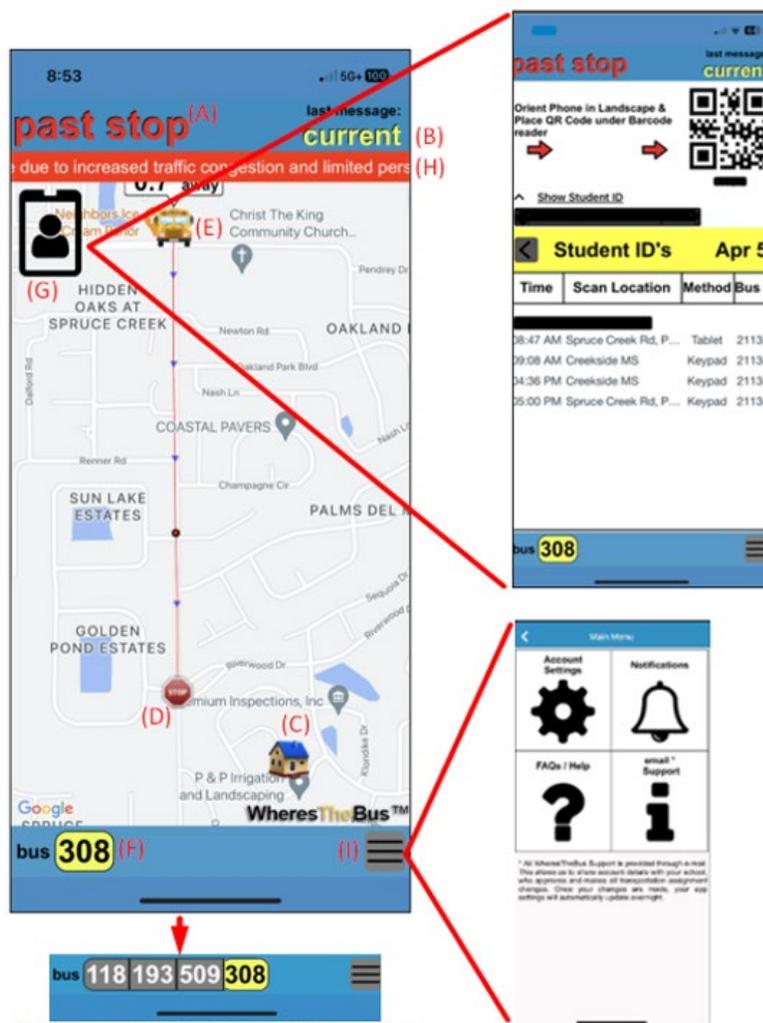

Screen Overview

- (A) Arrival status: This indicates the estimated time of bus arrival when it can be predicted. Possible values include ETA, Approaching, At Stop, or Past Stop messages.
- (B) Last message: This displays the application's last update. If the message says "Current," it means bus data has been received within the last minute. If "Current" does not show, it indicates that bus data hasn't been received in the last 15 minutes. In such cases, the bus is likely stopped at a school, on layover, or inactive.
- (C) Student's home.
- (D) Student's Bus Stop.
- (E) Bus Location and Distance.
- (F) Click on the Bus# to switch between AM, PM, or students' routes. It will display both the AM and PM bus routes (if they share the same number, it will show only once) for each student added to the account. The selected route will be highlighted in yellow, corresponding to the data shown on the screen.
- (G) Student's information: Click here to access student information, barcode, route schedule, scan locations, and bus number.
- (H) Alert banner.
- (I) Settings Main Menu.



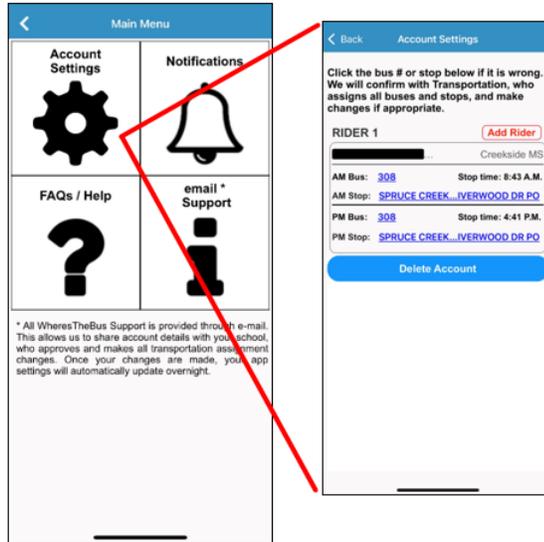

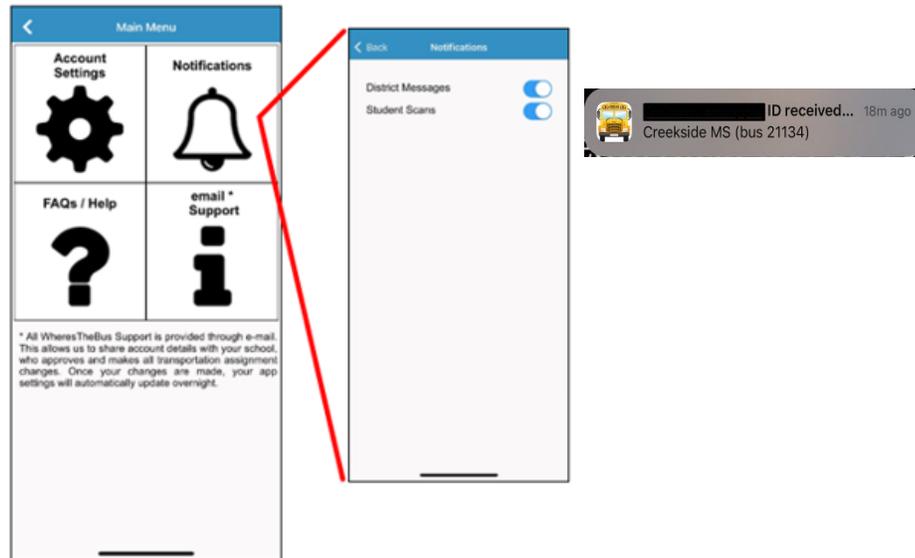

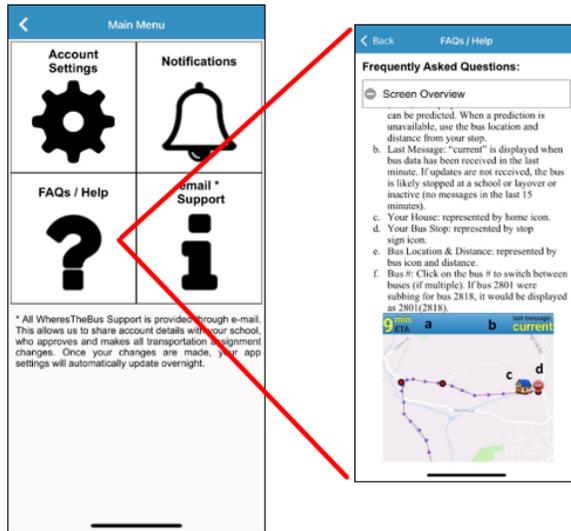

- ✓ Student Scans: Will notify every time the student scans his/her ID in the bus.

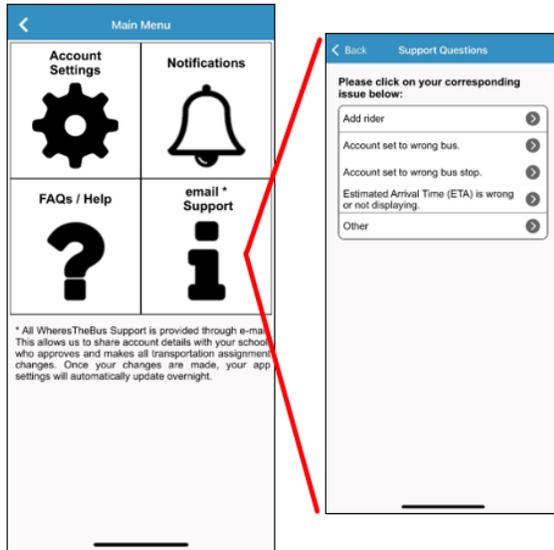
