

JSUPPLEMENTAL MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

SUPPLEMENTAL MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS AND BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE CHAPPAQUA CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT, hereinafter referred to as “the District” and **THE CHAPPAQUA CONGRESS OF TEACHERS**, hereinafter referred to as “the CCT”;

WHEREBY, the District and the CCT believe it to be in their mutual best to settle the grievance filed by the CCT dated 9/17/23 regarding class load in 7th grade at Bell Middle School.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is agreed as follows:

7th grade classroom teachers, whose average class size exceeds 25 students in class, shall be entitled additional to \$500 per student, per semester (prorated and retroactive) payment, not to exceed a total payment of \$1,000 per semester in the aggregate for all such classes.

This supplemental memorandum of agreement shall be non-precedent setting, and not to be introduced by either party in any future proceedings {negotiations, administrative or judicial} and shall sunset effective close of business, June 30, 2024.

The above mentioned grievance is hereby withdrawn with prejudice against being refiled under the parties’ grievance procedure, in arbitration, or any other forum.

SO AGREED this May day of 17th, 2024, subject to ratification by the Board of Education.
