Transitional Kindergarten Supplies

Please label items 1-5 with your child's name:

1. Backpack large enough for lunch box, folder, reusable water bottle, and rest supplies
2. Rest Supplies: Beach towel or blanket, (no bigger than 3 feet by 5 feet) and a labeled pillowcase to hold the blanket, travel sized pillow is optional. Stuffed animals are not necessary.
3. One (1) set of 8 [watercolor paints palette](#)
4. One (1) [horizontal pocket folder](#)
5. One (1) Plastic pencil box for student supplies

Do not label:

- One (1) box of [washable Crayola markers](#) (basic colors, 10-pack)
- One (1) box of [crayons \(24-pack\)](#)
- One (1) multi-pack Expo Dry Erase markers, Fine Tip
- Eight (8) [glue sticks](#)
- One (1) K-2 [Mead Primary Journal](#) (drawing space + ½ page primary ruled lines)
- One (1) pair of Fiskars 2-finger scissors
- Two (2) boxes of tissues

Clothing:

- Send a change of underwear and clothes in a plastic bag, in case of an accident. We will store in our classroom.
- Athletic shoes which provide strong, lateral support are to be worn daily. If shoes have laces, your child should know how to tie their shoes.
- Girls, when wearing dresses, should wear play shorts underneath.
- Transitional Kindergartners who are unable to snap, button, or zip their pants should wear pants with an *elastic* waistband.

Kindergarten Supplies

Please label items 1-5 with your child's name:

1. Backpack large enough for lunch box, folder, and rest supplies
2. Rest Supplies: Beach towel or blanket (**no bigger than 3 feet by 5 feet**) and a pillowcase to hold blanket: *no pillows, sleeping bags or mattresses, please*
3. Three (3) [folders](#) with pockets at the bottom, not on the sides. Cover pictures consistent with Christian values. Please, put name on the top right front.
4. One (1) [Headset](#) (corded)- Opened, labeled and placed in a labeled gallon-sized Ziploc bag
5. One (1) pair of blunt tip [scissors](#) - Fiskars preferred (safety scissors often do not cut well)

Do not label:

- Twelve (12) [pencils](#) (Ticonderoga brand) - sharpened
- Three (3) boxes of 24 pack [crayons](#) (Crayola brand)
- Two (2) boxes of [facial tissue](#)/Kleenex
- Six (6) [glue sticks](#) (preferably jumbo white glue sticks like Scotch or Elmer's, but no clear or purple disappearing glue please – it doesn't stick well)
- One (1) large polymer [eraser](#)
- One (1) K-2 [Mead Primary Journal](#) (drawing space + ½ page primary ruled lines)
- Four (4) black [dry erase markers](#) (fine or chisel tip)

Clothing:

- Send a change of underwear and clothes in a labelled plastic bag, in case of an accident. We will store in our classroom.
- Athletic shoes which provide strong, lateral support are to be worn **daily**. If shoes have laces, your child should know how to tie their shoes.
- Girls, when wearing dresses, should wear play shorts underneath.
- Kindergartners who are unable to snap, button, or zip their pants should wear pants with an *elastic* waistband.

1st Grade Supplies

1. Three (3) [pocket folders](#) (Cover pictures must be compatible with Christian values.) No paper folders.
2. Two (2) boxes of 24 [crayons](#). No larger boxes please. No scented crayons. Crayons need to fit in the supply box.
3. [Scissors](#) with blunt tip (non-plastic.) Fiskars work well.
4. Twenty-four (24) [Sharpened #2 pencils](#). (Ticonderoga)
5. Reusable water bottles labeled
6. One (1) school box (5" x 8") big enough for following supplies: pencils, eraser, crayons, scissors and glue (Make sure crayons can fit in supply box.) *NO* pouches or over-sized supply boxes please
7. One (1) [Composition Notebook](#)
8. [Headphones](#) for use with iPads (labeled in a bag. To be kept at school.) **No Earbuds!**
9. Four (4) [dry-erase markers](#) (black)
10. Two (2) white polymer erasers

Last Name (A-M)- Two (2) packages of [Baby Wipes](#)

Last Name (N-Z)- Two (2) boxes of [Facial Tissues](#) (200+)

Science supply:

Last name (A-M) – [Paper towels](#)

Last name (N-Z) – 4 [glue sticks](#)

1. One (1) [school box](#) (5" x 8") big enough for following supplies: pencils, eraser, crayons, scissors and glue (Make sure crayons can fit in supply box.) *NO* pouches or over-sized supply boxes please
2. Two (2) [sturdy pocket folders](#). Cover picture compatible with Christian values, please These should be strong enough to stand when open. Besides providing storage for our papers, we will use them as walls between students at tables.
3. Two (2) boxes of 24 [crayons](#)
4. One (1) box of [markers](#) (no large sets)
5. Three (3) dozen #2 [pencils](#), [sharpened](#)
6. Two (2) medium soft [erasers](#)
7. Two (2) [glue sticks](#)
8. Five (5) skinny [highlighters](#) (pink, blue, yellow, orange, green)
9. Four (4) black [dry erase markers](#)
10. Two (2) [composition notebooks](#)
11. [Scissors](#) with blunt tips, non-plastic. Last year's scissors are fine
12. English Standard Version (ESV) Bible (Old and New Testament)
13. One water bottle (NOT disposable)
14. Backpack, roll case, or book bag large enough for supplies
15. Two (2) regular boxes of [facial tissues](#) (200+ sheets)
16. Three (3) boxes of [baby wipes](#)
17. Two (2) rolls of [paper towels](#)
18. Athletic shoes which provide strong lateral support, to be worn all day

7. [Scissors](#) with blunt tips (not plastic, labeled)

9. One (1) box of 12 [colored pencils](#)
10. [Earbuds](#) or [headphones](#) (not wireless, labeled)
11. One (1) [large](#) box of [Kleenex](#) for classroom supply
12. One (1) roll of [paper towels](#)
13. Four (4) [large](#) packages of [baby wipes](#) (fragrance-free)
14. One (1) of each color skinny [highlighters](#): yellow, blue, pink, orange, green
15. Three (3) [composition notebooks](#)
16. [English Standard Version \(ESV\)](#) Bible with Old and New Testaments
17. Backpack, roll case or book bag large enough for all supplies
18. Girls, when wearing dresses or skirts, must wear play shorts underneath all day
19. Athletic shoes which provide strong lateral support, to be worn all day

1. Four (4) 2-pocket [folders](#) (Heavy Duty, if possible)
2. Two (2) packs of wide-ruled [binder paper](#)

4. One (1) medium soft [eraser](#)
5. One (1) [12" ruler](#) with inch, centimeter, and millimeter measurements (acrylic, not flexible)
6. One (1) [pencil box](#) (plastic only) large enough for supplies
7. Two (2) [glue sticks](#)
8. One (1) pair of [scissors](#) with blunt tips (one per class)
9. Two (2) boxes of [colored pencils](#) (box of 12-24)
10. One (1) yellow [highlighter](#)
11. One (1) [clipboard](#)
12. [Earbuds](#) or [Headphones](#) for use with iPads (labeled in a bag, to be kept at school)
13. One (1) [red pen](#) (erasable, if possible)
14. One (1) [permanent, black marker](#) (i.e. Sharpie)
15. One (1) pencil sharpener
16. Three (3) [composition notebooks](#)
17. Backpack (you don't need a giant one)
18. Lunch box
19. Two (2) boxes of [tissues](#)
20. One (1) pack of [disinfecting wipes](#).
21. Athletic shoes which provide strong, lateral support to be worn all day

Note:

5th Grade Supplies

All supplies should be replenished as needed throughout the year:

1. [12" ruler](#) with inch and millimeter markings (Make sure "0" point is easily identifiable. Don't get the flexible rubber rulers. Their markings are unreliable.)
2. Large [pencil bag](#)
3. [Eraser](#) (rectangular)
4. [Scissors](#) with blunt tips
5. ESV Bible
6. [Colored pencils](#) (box of 12 or 24)
7. Multi-pack of [highlighters](#) (5 colors)
8. [Earbuds](#) or [Headphones](#) for use with iPads (to be kept at school)
9. Four (4) 100-sheet [composition notebooks](#)
10. Two (2) [pocket folders](#) (plain or with pictures consistent with RCS values)
11. Backpack, roll case or book bag large enough for supplies.
12. Athletic shoes which provide strong lateral support, to be worn all day
13. Two (1) dry-erase markers
14. One (1) box of crayons
15. One (1) protractor

Please do NOT label these items:

1. Four packages (4) #2 hardness [pencils](#)
2. Two (2) red [pens](#) (not markers)
3. Two (2) glue sticks
4. One (1) [bottle school glue](#)
5. Two (2) regular boxes of [facial tissue](#)
6. One (1) box of [baby wipes](#)

8. Two (2) packages of [sticky notes](#)
9. 500 sheets of 8 1/2" x 11" college-ruled, loose-leaf [binder paper](#) with smooth edges. (No spiral notebooks or tear-out notebooks of lined paper.)
