

- Tax Shelter Annuities and Disability Insurance Providers. The Board approved companies to be Tax Shelter Annuity/After Tax Plans and Disability Insurance providers.
- Claims Auditor Pre-Payment Authority. The Board designated the School Business Administrator as the Claims Auditor.

- Prescription Renewal Rates. The Board approved an amendment to the contract with SHIF for a one-year renewal effective July 1, 2022 – June 30, 2023.
- Dental Renewal Rates. The Board approved a contract with Delta Dental to provide a one-year renewal effective July 1, 2022 – June 30, 2023.
- Property & Casualty Insurance Renewal Rates.
 The Board adopted the property & casualty insurance rates for the 2022-23 fiscal year.
- School Health Insurance Fund & Indemnity and Trust Agreement. The Board approved membership in the School Health Insurance Fund (SHIF) and execution of the Indemnity and Trust Agreement.
- Agreement with Woolwich Township for Fuel.
 The Board approved an agreement with Woolwich Township to supply fuel for Emergency Response Vehicles, Police Vehicles, Public Works Vehicles and Code Vehicles should the need arise through December 2025.
- Bid Award Trash Services. The Board awarded the bid for Trash/Recycle Removal Services to Waste Management of New Jersey, Inc.
