SUBJECT: ADMINISTRATIVE AUTHORITY DURING ABSENCE OF THE SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS

The Superintendent of Schools shall delegate to the Acting Superintendent the authority and responsibility for making decisions and taking such actions as may be required during the absence of the Superintendent.

The senior administrator in possession of School District Administrator certification is appointed as Acting Superintendent at the annual meeting. In the absence of both the Superintendent and the Acting Superintendent, authority will be delegated to another administrator.
