English – One Day on our Blue Planet

This half term our English will be based on the text 'One Day on our Blue Planet' By Ella Bayley, a fantastic picture non-fiction text about the day in the life of a lion cub in the African Savannah. Showing African animals in their natural surroundings and a wonderful opportunity to explore and extend vocabulary through non-fiction writing and exploring settings and animals through poetry.

RE caring for others

We will be continuing with our learning on how we can be kind to each other and look after one another. Children will learn about kindness and the importance of caring for others, by exploring the values of different religions.

PSHE/RSE – changing me

We will focus on how we grow and change and transition into year 2. Talk about moving to a new class with a different teacher. Discussing and sharing any worries about a new teacher and classroom learning space. Understand which parts of the body are private and the different parts of the body.

Year 1 Curriculum Overview- Summer 2



Maths

In maths we will be finding and recognising a half and quarter of a shape, object and quantity. Learn about position and direction, using the language left, right, forwards, backwards, above, below and use ordinal numbers. Place value of numbers to 100, using our knowledge of tens and ones, number lines, comparing numbers and identify one more and one less. We will also look at money focusing on the different coins and notes.

Science – Animals including humans and seasonal changes.

Through our learning the children will identify, name and label the basic parts of the human body as well as naming the five senses. Learning which part of the body is associated with which sense. We will also be observing the changes to the environment that happen in summertime.

Computing – Programming animations

The children will be introduced to on-screen programming through Scratch Jr, on the IPAD's. The children will explore the way a project looks by investigating sprites and backgrounds. We will learn to modify and create programs.

Geography – African Savannah

Through our geography we will be exploring and using simple maps, discussing what we have seen on a map, making simple maps. We will be identifying similarities and differences between 2 places (African Savannah and a place in the UK).

History Our planet and Travel

Through our history we will be exploring the history of flight, ordering the history of flight and exploring the work of the Wright brothers.

DT – Den making

Through our DT learning we will be discussing and drawing our ideas using words and pictures and making simple models. We will be identifying materials and mechanisms in familiar products as well as using simple construction kits. We will be exploring how structures can be made stronger, stiffer and more stable for our animal hides.

Art

We will be looking back at a previous artist studied during the year, Henri Rousseau, alongside our class text to develop and use a wider range of art and design techniques using colour, pattern, texture, line, shape, form and space to create different drawings and paintings.

Physical Education (PE) – unit 6 Health and Fitness.

During this unit the children will learn why exercise is important for good health. Develop their agility skills in ball chasing and static balances on the floor.
