### NOTRE DAME SCHOOL OF BETHLEHEM

Dear Parents,

According to Pennsylvania Law, nonpublic school children are entitled to transportation to nonpublic schools as follows:

- 1. A district, which provides transportation for resident public school students, must also make identical provisions for the transportation of resident nonpublic school students according to the nonpublic school calendar.
- Transportation for nonpublic school students must be provided to and from the nonpublic school in which the student is 2. enrolled, even if the nonpublic school is located outside the district so long as the distance is not more than 10 miles beyond the district boundaries. (NOTE: This distance may be in excess of 10 miles from a student's home.)
- A district may transport children who live along hazardous routes even though the children live within walking distance of 3. the school.


