Indian Creek High School Is Only School in State of Ohio Involved in Hellbender Program



Indian Creek High School is the only public school to be part of a pilot project to raise and release Hellbenders back into the wild. The first of the large salamanders that ICBS received is three-years old and has been named Chief by a vote from all the schools in the district. It is a collaboration with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources (ODNR) and the Columbus Zoo. Science teacher Crystal Fluharty and assistant principal Keith Swearingen have worked on the project with the Jefferson County Soil and Water Conservation District for over a year. Jefferson County is a main habitat of the species with the eggs for the project being harvested from Cross Creek. One room at the high school has been equipped to create a bio-secure environment for the hellbender thanks to a grant for \$15,000 from the Indian Creek Foundation.





All- OVAC first team honors were bestowed on Landon Pownall, Ty Householder, and Sal Barcalow.


















Graduation 2024


