Overview

Qualifications and Personal Attributes

That experience should include significant administrative leadership, effective team-building with all constituents, ability to mentor and empower members of the administrative team, and successful working relationships with boards of trustees. Similarly important will be a warm, accessible, and collaborative spirit

The following qualities and qualifications will be important for the Interim Head of School:

- Vast experience and knowledge of Pre-K to Grade 9 independent school organizational structures and operations;
- Strong oral and written communication skills, including the ability to articulate Pike's Mission, Vision, and Values across the community and tell The Pike School story both internally and externally;
- A highly relational, inclusive leader with strong emotional intelligence, particularly in building teams, relationships, and communities;
- Skill in helping community members of varying perspectives find common ground and advance shared goals; and
- A clear understanding of the varied roles of an Interim Head of School, in particular the paired imperatives of listening and learning, as well as leading, as one enters a new community and prepares it for subsequent leadership.
