Please read, review & share with your child

- #1. All paid yearbooks can be picked up at lunch on Monday & Tuesday (6/3-4) with Student ID (or after school in room 88).
- #2. Brightly colored name “stickers” and markers will be provided to write names in the books. Write names in several hidden places-in case of confusion over who “owns” a book.
- #3. Be careful when loaning books to others to sign it. Keep track of who has it and make sure it is returned.
- #4. Do not leave books lying around or leave them and walk off. Prevent theft by keeping books close at all times.
- #5. Please do not destroy or take other people’s books. Write positive things only on others’ yearbooks. Be kind when signing.
- #6. Jostens & RVMS are not responsible for lost, stolen or misplaced books. There will be no refunds or replacements.
