#### Kindergarten: Oral Health Assessment Form is Due May 31

California law requires that students enrolled in kindergarten receive an oral health assessment by a licensed dental health professional, and submit a completed <u>Oral Health</u> <u>Assessment Form</u> to the child's school. Oral health assessments must occur between 12 months prior to the start of Kindergarten and the end of the Kindergarten year on May 31.

To fulfill the requirement, please complete and submit this <u>Oral Health Assessment Form</u>, as follows. Parent/guardian must complete:

- Section #1. Licensed dental professional must fill out and sign or stamp
- Section #2. Parent/guardian must return the completed form to the St. John's Health Office by Friday, May 31. To claim an exemption from this requirement, parent/guardian must complete Section #3 and return to the Health Office by Friday, May 31.
