## Uniform Guidelines

Middle school uniforms are purchased from Lands' End and have the Eastside Catholic logo on all pieces. The Parent Teacher Fellowship (PTF) will also hold periodic used uniform sales throughout the school year.

Students are required to be in uniform Monday through Thursday except for special occasions as determined by the middle school principal. On Fridays, students may dress in EC spirit wear following the dress code guidelines listed below.

### Uniform Information and Expectations

- All students are expected to be in uniform for picture day.
- Middle school students must be in uniform at school unless otherwise noted.
- All uniform items display the school logo and must be purchased from Lands' End.
- Polo shirt options include orange and navy, and there are several styles within the Middle School Uniform Policy to choose from.
- Uniform bottoms include several Lands' End styles of khaki and navy-blue pants, shorts, skirts and skorts.
- Any combination of orange or navy uniform shirt and khaki or navy uniform bottoms are permitted.
- Uniform shorts, skorts and skirts should fall mid-thigh or longer.
- The uniform sweatshirt is available in a pullover or zip-front style in navy and gray. Orange uniform sweatshirts previously purchased are grandfathered in.
- The uniform sweatshirt is meant as outerwear for warmth; students still must wear their uniform polo shirt.
- Uniform sweatshirts, uniform sweaters and uniform jackets are the only approved outer layer of clothing once the school day begins.
- Tights or leggings in a solid color may be worn under the uniform.

### General Dress Code Information

- On Fridays, students may wear spirit dress or their uniforms. Spirit Wear must include Eastside Catholic clothing as an outermost top layer. Spirit Wear is any EC shirt or sweatshirt (must adhere to dress code) - either from an EC athletic team or purchased at the Orange Crush spirit store. Students may wear anything on the bottom like jeans, sweatpants, and shorts, which do not need to be EC branded.
- All logos in writing on clothing must be school-appropriate.
- Tops must have shoulder straps and be long enough to adequately cover the waistline and not expose the midriff. If wearing a hoodie or jacket, tops underneath that are visible should follow the dress code.
- No undergarments should be visible at any time.
- All pants, leggings, shorts, skirts and dresses must be free of holes that reveal private areas or undergarments.
- Students are required to wear shoes. Soft-soled slippers and shoes with wheels are not allowed.
- Clothing and accessories that could be distracting in class are not permitted at the discretion of the teacher.
- Specific classes may have shoe and/or clothing requirements such as close-toed shoes for science labs. Follow the teacher's instructions.
- Shoes are required. Shoes with wheels and soft-soled slippers are not allowed.
