Middle School Soccer Coach will

- Provide leadership in player development and game preparation.
- Provide weekly communication with players and parents on logistics and scheduling.
- Work in collaboration with Athletic Director/Assistant Athletic Director to handle other official content related to the middle school soccer program
- Devote commitment, passion, and energy into all Sacred Heart athletic teams, including but not limited to attending sporting events and supporting fellow coaches and the Sacred Heart student-athletes.
- Position requires practices 2-3 times a week including matches/games.
