Fall Junior Year

- Identify careers & majors of interest
- Take competitive courses
- Begin a college search
- Take the PSAT
- Create a resume

Spring Junior Year

- Register and take the SAT/ACT test for the first time
- Create a list of 10-15 schools of interest
- Attend the National College Fair in Hartford
- Visit college's open houses
- Ask a teacher and counselor for a letter of recommendation

Summer heading into Senior Year

- Update your resume
- Create a Common Application account
- Work on your college essays
- Continue visiting colleges
- Narrow your list down to 5-8 schools

Fall Senior Year

- Narrow list down to 4-6 schools
- Apply to colleges
 - Application
 - Letters of Recommendation
 - Send your SAT scores
- Safety, match and reach schools
- Take the SAT/ACT Test for the 2nd time

Winter Senior Year

- Continue to apply to colleges
- Complete the your FAFSA
- Update your Resume
- Apply for local, state, and national scholarships

Spring Senior Year

- Make and notify colleges of your official decision
- Continue applying for scholarships
- Attend Freshmen Orientation
- Register for your college classes
- Request TRMC transcript
 - Request TRCC transcript
