Please Read This Important Information:



- **First Week of school:**

We are typically a closed campus, however on the first seven days of school, we will permit families to walk their students to class and/or wait with their students until the bell rings at 8:15 am. At that time, we'll invite you to "Hug-N-Go!" Our closed campus policy will begin on Monday, 8/19.

- **Attendance Notification:**

If your student is not planning on attending Sandra J. Gallardo due to a move, attending another school. etc., please notify the school office at (916) 294-9170. Also, if your student will not be at school the first three days, please be aware that your student will be dis-enrolled.

- **Arrival Time:**

There is no supervision on the playground/school area until 8:10 a.m. No students are to be on campus prior to that time. Upon arrival, students are to wait near the designated entrance/exit area for their grade level. Students arriving before this time will be asked to return home and parents will be notified.

- **Medications:**

If your child requires medication at school, you will need to have your child's physician complete a F.C.U.S.D. Authorization For The Administration Of Medication By School Personnel for each prescription medication. For non-prescription medication (including lip-balm, cough drops and sun-block) a F.C.U.S.D. Authorization For The Administration Of Non-Prescription Over-The-Counter Medication In School Form must be completed for each non-prescription item. [Health Forms](#)

- **Visitors/Volunteers on Campus:**

All visitors / volunteers must sign-in at the school office before entering the campus and receive an identification sticker while on campus. Volunteers in the classroom or on a field trip must complete or update a Volunteer Category 2 form, have a current T.B. test on file and be fingerprinted through F.C.U.S.D. Volunteers may not bring siblings. For safety reasons, children are not allowed in the staff workroom or staff lounge area.
