In addition to the Valedictorian, Salutatorian, and STEM Scholars listed above, the following departmental awards were recognized at the May 19 Baccalaureate celebration for the Class of 2024. Recipients of these awards and more will be posted on our website.

Angel Ambassador of the Year Award

The Angel Ambassador of the Year Award recognizes a senior who has served as an Angel Ambassador for St. Joe by participating in High School Night Presentations, leading Open House tours, and hosting shadow visitors.

Rosemary Wellington Award

The Rosemary Wellington Award honors long-time athletic director Rosemary Wellington. She was responsible for establishing all of the SJA athletic programs. The award was established in 1990 and is presented to an athlete who demonstrates leadership ability, good sportsmanship, and the "Not I, But We" attitude in and out of the athletic arena.

St. Joseph the Worker Award

The St. Joseph the Worker Award is given to a student who embodies the ideals that we admire in St. Joseph: Humility, Servant Leadership, and Trust to take action to fulfill God's plan. Campus Ministry is excited to present this award to a senior who has lived out the values of St. Joseph through her involvement at St. Joe and in the greater St. Louis area.

Computer Science and Engineering Award

The Computer Science and Engineering Department Award recognizes a student who shows excellence in the field throughout her years at St. Joe.

LuAnn Worrall Outstanding Achievement in English Award

This English department award is named after longtime English teacher Mrs. LuAnn Worrall. It is awarded to students who exemplify excellence in English.

Global Scholars

The designation of a Global Education Scholar is awarded at the end of senior year. This achievement signifies that the student has completed the Academic, Language, and Cultural Immersion, Service Learning, and Engagement milestones of the program and has extensive involvement in the Global Scholars program.

Global Education Citizen of the Year Award

The Global Education Citizen of the Year Award is given to a senior who demonstrates her commitment to being a Global Education Scholar. This person seeks new opportunities, other cultures, and multiple perspectives while demonstrating resilience in navigating unfamiliar situations. It is someone we expect will carry these values with them throughout

their life and will go out and make a profound impact on the world.

Bud Stein Mathematics Award

This mathematics department award, formerly known as the Sister Anne Agnes von Steiger Award, recognizes a senior with a passion for mathematics. Mr. Bud Stein taught at St. Joseph's Academy from 1985 to 2024, leaving a lasting mark on the institution. Not only did he pioneer the first engineering course, but he also founded the Billiken Beams, the Rocket Club, and the legendary Club Sandwich.

Sister Nancy Folkl Science Award

The Sister Nancy Folkl Science Award was established in 2001 to honor Sister Nancy who served at St. Joseph Academy as principal and biology teacher. The criteria for the award are the number of science courses taken, academic excellence achieved in those classes, participation in co-curricular science activities, and an interest in pursuing further studies in some area of science.

Social Studies Award

The Social Studies department recognizes a senior who has exhibited enthusiasm for Social Studies and who has excelled in her knowledge and contribution to the subject.

Santa Cuddihee Award

The Santa Cuddihee Award honors the forty-six years of service and dedication that Santa Cuddihee so generously shared with the SJA community from 1969 to 2015. This Theology Department award recognizes a senior student who exemplifies the spirituality of Santa Cuddihee: her inner strength, patience, wisdom, and the ability to recognize the dignity of self and others.

Julie Schaeffer ('94) Art Award for Excellence in Visual Arts

The Julie Schaeffer ('94) Art Award for Excellence in Visual Arts recognizes a senior student who has achieved outstanding accomplishments in the visual arts and for her dedication and commitment to excellence in the arts beyond the classroom.

Sister Pam Harding Award

The Sister Pam Harding Award was established in 2001 to honor Sister Pam who served at St. Joseph Academy as an assistant principal and French teacher. The recipients show a true passion for using world languages and for learning about cultures different from their own, both in and outside of the classroom.
