Mr. Weaver commented that girls wrestling is a huge growing sport and it was good to see that there will be a coach. He asked if there is a girls coaching position at Valley and why it's a half time position.

Ms. Bilotti indicated that currently Valley does not have this position since there are no girls who have expressed interest. She said when there is interest then there will be a similar position. She indicated that girls only wrestling meets are on Sundays and the co-ed meets are not. She mentioned that the coach would be there for the girls only meets and some of the practices and they will evaluate how that is working. She indicated that there are potentially two other girls who expressed interest. She said if all three girls want to wrestle in co-ed meets then she would ask for a full-time position.

Mr. Weaver said he would like to see a coach who can also work with the boys team and recruit girls instead of waiting for girls to express interest.

Mr. Blundo asked if money was a concern for going with a part-time coach.

Ms. Bilotti said she is unsure if this is based on interest or if budgetary constraints were considered.

Mr. Stankus asked if there were girls wrestling prior to now.

Ms. Biotti said that there has not been a girl wrestling in several decades and she didn't believe there was at Valley.

Ms. Stephans asked if there was interest at Valley, would they go to Hills and be coached there. Ms. Bilotti indicated that would not be the case since the programs are run separately. The coach could go to both locations and expand or hire another coach. She said the intent was that the district is moving forward with girls wrestling and she wouldn't be surprised if it changes before the start of the season.

Mrs. Martin commented that this is great to get this out for girls who may want to wrestle and have a girls coach.

Mr. Weaver said he didn't know how wrestling works with the state. He mentioned that the dance team is combined with both schools.

Ms. Bilotti said she was informed that they could not combine for wrestling. It would need to be separate.

Mr. Blundo clarified that girls would be a part of the co-ed team and a girls team. He asked if the girl(s) at Hills and girl(s) at Valley could practice together.

Ms. Bilotti indicated that the girls coach could coach at both schools. She didn't know the rules if girls at the different schools could practice together.

Mr. Blundo asked if a girls golf coach was added at Valley similar to Hills.

Ms. Bilotti said that it may happen at Valley in the spring.

Mr. Weaver said he is confused on how teams can combine since there are others like the swim team that are combined.

Mr. Blundo mentioned hockey and dance.

Mr. Stankus thought it might be the league, the area and who they are competing against.

Mrs. Martin thought that there are certain organizations that allow it.

Mr. Blundo suggested that the athletic directors come and explain what defines a regional team and what prohibits one.

Ms. Bilotti said that dance, gymnastics and cheer are not regulated by NJSIAA. She did not know the history of swim and hockey.

XV. COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC

Citizens are invited to make comments and are limited to three minutes, according to the Pascack Valley Regional High School District Board of Education policy number 0167. Persons wishing to speak must, upon being recognized, rise, sign in and state their name and town of residence.

Mr. Anthony DeRosa, the Hillsdale council member liaison to the Board, commented that he has been a council member for 10 years and liaison to the Board for about the same length of time. He mentioned that he has attended the meetings faithfully. He comments that he is running for mayor and if the residents of Hillsdale believe he has done a good job then he would appreciate their support.

Ms. Viat Bekker of River Vale commented that she sent an email to the Board and spoke to Ms. Bilotti regarding her home schooled child to participate in extracurricular activities. She mentioned that she is very active in the community. She indicated that one son is interested in Robotics, however there are no clubs in the area. Mr. Blundo said he is the longest tenured board member (9 years) and he indicated that he has not seen this request. The two principals did not recall this request and they have been in the district longer than Mr.. Blundo. He mentioned that the policy would be reviewed by the policy committee and they will make a recommendation to the Board if a change in policy is needed. Mr. Blundo requested that a committee meeting be scheduled soon.

XIV. ADJOURNMENT

A motion was made by Mrs. Varghese to adjourn the public meeting at 8:52 p.m. Ms. Stephans seconded the motion, which was unanimously carried.
