XIII. NEW BUSINESS

Ms. Calderone understood that the gym doors were being left ajar which is a safety concern.

Ms. Bilotti indicated that the front doors are locked and if something needs to be dropped off, it is placed in a bin outside the door. She mentioned that she will remind the principals. She added that when an outside organization uses the facilities, they are paying for security, so the gym doors may be propped open. The custodial staff do their best to close any open doors.

Mr. Blundo commented that the facility use form should indicate that no doors can be propped open.

Ms. Calderone, who works for the County of Bergen mentioned attending a teen dating and violence workshop run by the Alternative to Domestic Violence Department. She is coordinating with the county and with Jennifer Zimmerman and Christie Rossig (Student Assistance

Counselors) to run a program at the high school mainly for freshmen and seniors, but also branching out to the middle schools.

Ms. Stephans commented that she attended the "Best College Fit" presentation which she found very informative. It was given by Peter VanBuskirk, best selling author and dean of admissions. She mentioned that it was well attended with more parents than students.

XIV. COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC

Citizens are invited to make comments and are limited to three minutes, according to the Pascack Valley Regional High School District Board of Education policy number 0167. Persons wishing to speak must, upon being recognized, rise, sign in and state their name and town of residence.

Mr. Scott Shaw of River Vale said he sent an email to the Board on October 17 regarding the Pascack Valley concession stand. He mentioned that there is an inequity between Valley and Hills. He said he received some information through OPRA and he understood that the concession was run by the student council. This concerned him that there has not been a concession stand for almost 10 years. He feels that the Board has an obligation to uphold policy and make things equal between the two schools. This has not afforded the student council to raise funds for their needs. He indicated that a concession stand was in a long range financial plan in December 2013 and construction plans in 2015 which was presented to the Board with a completion in 2018. Mr. Shaw mentioned lost opportunities for students to raise funds. He indicated that there are food trucks that are organized by the Gridiron Club for football. He said it's concerning since parents raise funds and then need to pay for permits. He said he would like to know what is being done.

Mr. Blundo thanked Mr. Shaw and he said it will be on the agenda of the next Facilities Committee Meeting.

Mr. Mike Smith of River Vale thanked the people who volunteer their time inside and outside of the room to improve the school system and to provide the children with a top notch education. He mentioned that he coached his sons in a variety of sports and now he volunteers as a photographer and videographer for all levels of sports. He said he is in support of Mr. Shaw and he said something needs to be done to get a much needed concession stand as Pascack Hills has. Mr. Smith indicated that he served on the Board of the River Vale Raiders and they raised thousands of dollars through the concessions to help pay for their needs. He mentioned that a concession would help for additional out-of-pocket costs and assist the student council. He believes the Board should act to reopen the concession stand and make this a priority.

XV. ADJOURNMENT

A motion was made by Ms. Stephans to adjourn the public meeting at 7:59 p.m. Mrs. Varghese seconded the motion, which was unanimously carried.
