Mr. Weaver asked about obtaining data on how the students are using the writing center. A comparison of this year to last year since ESSER funds are being utilized this year. How many hours the center has been used. He asked if the center is being utilized for certain purposes. Is it being used by students who do not need support and not reaching students who are struggling. Is it meeting student needs for those who need it and do not necessarily seek assistance. He mentioned a larger conversation about college and technical education and how it is teased out to accomplish the Board's goals this year.

XII. OLD BUSINESS

Mr. Weaver asked about a discussion last year regarding a cell tower.

Mr. Usami indicated that the district is still investigating the possibility. Verizon has said they have no interest at this time. Verizon did ask about a large cell tower a number of years ago. The current piece of equipment is about the size of a large trash can. The District reached out to an architect who had helped another district secure the equipment/service from Verizon. The architect works with a third party to see if Verizon or AT&T Mobile would be interested. There has been no interest thus far.

Ms. Bilotti indicated that we do not have much control over this. She mentioned that Mr. Zeller investigated the idea of having boosters. However, that was not an option since the cell signal is so low. She said she has reached out to the local Congressman's office since there is funding available for this type of service. The Congressman said he would look into it. She suggested reaching out to local and state representatives or even the U.S. Congressional (Josh Gottheimer) who has been successful in rural areas. She indicated that she has spoken to the Hillsdale K-8 superintendent since they are affected. She pointed out that this affects residents as well. It's a larger problem than just the school.

Mr. Weaver asked if it would be worthwhile to craft a resolution and send it to those representatives.

Ms. Bilotti suggested getting the town councils involved. She indicated that a hurdle would be the cell tower would be a "real" cell tower (large structure). She added that another issue is where to place the tower since the property behind the school is not the District's land. There would need to be an agreement with the county to use the land. She said the District needs to determine the first step.

Mr. Weaver asked about a ballpark cost and a concern of who is responsible for the tower when it has reached its end of life.

Mr. Usami indicated that the companies pay to have the tower installed since it benefits them. This is what had occurred with the other district he mentioned previously, but that was for a tower the size of a large trash can. He indicated that he does not know whose responsibility it is when the tower has reached its end of life.
