VII. PRESENTATION

HIB Training - Rod Hara, Esquire presentation

Ms. Stephans asked if anything goes into a student's record if no HIB is found. Mr. Hara said that it would not go into a student's record. Only in the HIB file that documents what the district did or did not do. If HIB, a summary of conclusion of what was done as a result of the HIB and the finding goes into the student's record. Mrs. Martin wanted to confirm that when the superintendent reports to the Board that they are listening and not voting. Mr. Hara confirmed.

Ms. Bilotti explained that the first time the HIB case is presented in closed session and the Board listens. The second time the Board meets it's on the agenda for a vote. She indicated that the first time when she presents a HIB case is when the Board may ask questions, ask for more information, agree or disagree. She noted that she may be unable to share certain information because it may be too identifiable. Ms. Bilotti added that the district uses a program, Hibster, that produces reports that are appropriate for the Board and eliminates some of the subjectivity. It provides consistency and eliminates inadvertent biases.

Mr. Blundo said that sometimes the Board feels that they do not have enough information about the event. Mrs. Martin agreed that there was an instance where the Board needed more information.

Ms. Bilotti commented that if that is the case then she will provide the Board more information via email or discuss it in closed session before the vote.

Mr. Weaver asked what happens if the Board rejects the decision by the administration.

Mr. Hara said the decision would be overturned. The Board has that ability.

Ms. Bilotti and Mr. Hara added that the discipline cannot be overturned since if it's not HIB, it falls under Code of Conduct.

Mr. Hara indicated that the Board should take it incrementally. The individual does not matter. The Board must feel satisfied that they have enough facts so they may evaluate the decision based on the criteria of HIB.

Mr. Blundo wanted to know if a case is not determined to be HIB, if the case will come to the Board.

Mr. Hara clarified that if the principal determines that an incident does not satisfy the criteria then it does not go to the Board. It's handled as a Code of Conduct. If the principal cannot determine if it meets the criteria and starts an investigation to determine HIB or not then that case will come to the Board.

Mr. Weaver asked where the information goes. Is it into student records? He mentioned that there is a concern that it would follow to college as students are applying to college. Mr. Hara indicated that a HIB outcome goes into a student's record. No access is allowed unless it's authorized personnel, parental consent or a court order. He commented that those records do not transform to post high school. He added that a transfer to another high school then the record of disciplinary action will follow, but not the HIB investigative report.

38. Resolution Opposing the Proposed Increases to the School Employees Health Benefits Program

WHEREAS, the School Employees Health Benefits Program (SEHBP), governed by N.J.S.A.52:14-17.46 et seq., offers medical, prescription drug, and dental coverage to participating school district employees, retirees, and eligible dependents; and

WHEREAS, all SEHBP plans are self-funded, meaning that the money paid out for benefits comes directly from an SEHBP fund supplied by participating local employers and member premiums; and

WHEREAS, the Division of Pensions and Benefits is responsible for the daily administrative activities of the SEHPB, the School Employees Health Benefits Commission is the executive organization responsible for overseeing the SEHBP; and

WHEREAS, the School Employees Health Benefits Commission, comprised of state officials, union representatives and a representative of the New Jersey School Boards Association, annually considers the calendar year premium levels for the Local Education Employee Group of the SEHBP based on recommendations found in the Rate Setting Recommendation Analysis of the Local Education Employee Group; and

WHEREAS, the School Employees' Health Benefits Plan Design Committee has the

responsibility for and authority over the various plans and components of the plans, including for medical benefits, prescription benefits, dental, vision, and any other health care benefits, offered and administered by the SEHBP; and

WHEREAS, existing law requires three members of the School Employees' Health Benefits Plan Design Committee to be appointed by the Governor as representatives of public employers (i.e., local school districts) whose employees are enrolled in the program, but currently all such representatives are state-level appointees;

WHEREAS, the recommended rate changes for medical and prescription drug coverage for the Active 2023 Local Education Employer Group is 15.1%, which includes a 15.3% increase for active employees enrolled in NJ DIRECT 10/15 and a 14.9% increase for active employees enrolled in the NJ Educators Health Plan (NJEHP); and

WHEREAS, such proposed exorbitant rate increases will fall upon the local property taxpayer, as well as school employees, at a time where there is record inflation; and

WHEREAS, since employees enrolled the NJEHP pay a percentage of salary toward their health benefits per P.L.2020, c.44, commonly referred to as "Chapter 44", any increase in NJEHP premiums will fall almost entirely upon local boards of education, placing a severe strain on their budgets; and

WHEREAS, the proposed premium increase for most active employees will take thousands more out of their paychecks annually and lead to huge costs for local school districts that will translate into higher property tax bills for struggling families; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Pascack Valley Regional High School District Board of Education in the county of Bergen call upon the School Employees Health Benefits Commission to reconsider the rate increase and strike a rate increase that is appropriate in the current economic conditions; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Pascack Valley Regional High School District Board of Education in the county of Bergen urge the Legislature to adopt legislation expanding the composition of the School Employees Health Benefits Commission and the School Employees Health Benefits Plan Design Committee to include additional representatives from local school district management; and
