Mr. Usami indicated that there were a lot of requests as three teaching positions did not make the budget. The positions are Business, English and Spanish. If the funds are restored, then two teaching positions could be added.

Ms. Molinelli asked about State Aid.

Mr. Usami mentioned that the district received \$331,000 in additional State Aid which helped the budget. He said additional State Aid has been given to underfunded districts

like Pascack Valley Regional based on the funding formula. This is by way of the S2 law. He said we should anticipate additional State Aid next year.
