Mr. Blundo added that if circumstances dictate that the trip should be canceled then the Board may do so.

Mr. Weaver thought there was conversation that the restrictions on international would be re-evaluated in January by the CDC.

Mrs. Martin had concerns about having former students going on the trip and the district staff having responsibility for them.

Dr. Fishbein commented that he was surprised that the attorney and risk manager said these students would be covered by insurance. He said that these students are going for the right reason and their negative behavior could impact future trips.

Ms. Stephans wanted to make sure that the only reason these students are allowed to go is because they were unable to go due to the pandemic. Dr. Fishbein confirmed.
