31. Pomptonian Food Service Agreement

WHEREAS, the Pascack Valley Regional High School District Board of Education ("the Board") and Pomptonian Inc. ("the Contractor") are parties to a Food Service Agreement ("Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, on May 3, 2020, the Board renewed the Agreement for the 2020-2021 school year upon the basis that the Pascack Valley Regional High School District would be operating a normal schedule with a full lunch service program; and

WHEREAS, for the 2020-2021 school year, the District will be operating a half-day rotating schedule until such time there is no longer a public health emergency and/or the District returns to normal operations (full in-person instruction, five (5) days a week); and

WHEREAS, the District will not be providing a full lunch service program, but a grab and go lunch service; and

WHEREAS, the Parties are desirous of renewing the Agreement for the 2020-2021 school year at the negotiated rate of \$180 per day (which was the rate agreed upon for the remainder of the 2019-2020 school year pursuant to N.J.S.A 18A:7F-9) to cover all payroll costs, all purchases of food and supplies, and any other direct expenses associated with providing services to the District; and

WHEREAS, this rate shall remain until such time the District returns to normal operation, for the 2020-2021 school year.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Board at the recommendation of the Superintendent hereby approves the revised terms and conditions of the renewal agreement for the 2020-2021 school year, which is attached hereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the revised terms and conditions shall remain until such time the District returns to normal operations.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board President and Business Administrator are hereby authorized to execute the attached addendum, and any and all other documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board President and the Board Secretary are hereby authorized to execute the attached Addendum to the Agreement and any other documents necessary to effectuate the terms of this Resolution.

Mr. Fronte abstained on all.

Mr. Steinberg asked about Pomptonian providing Grab and Go lunches, if the district will make money and if there will be food waste.

Mr. Usami responded that Pomptonian will provide Grab and Go lunches for all students and the district hopes to make money. There is a possibility that if the surplus is exhausted a transfer will be made from the General Fund. He said Pomptonian will monitor lunch activity to avoid food waste.

Ms. Molinelli asked if transportation is ready.

Mr. Usami indicated that transportation is ready as the routes are on for renewal. Bergen Academies will be on the October 12 agenda since they will not open until October 19.

Mr. Steinberg asked if the routes will have double the buses.

Mr. Usami indicated that the routes will run at about half capacity with everyone wearing masks and that athletics is looking into doubling the number of buses.

Ms. Bissinger asked what happens if the district goes to remote learning.

Mr. Usami said that the law requires the district to pay the transporter, however the rate will be negotiated like last year.

Mr. Stankus asked if that is the case with food service.

Mr. Usami responded that the rate would be negotiated. If remote, the lunches for free and reduced would be prepared by Pomptonian at a neighboring district (Westwood Regional) like last year.

Mr. Scher asked about the Milestones lease.

Mr. Usami responded that he likes to have the board attorney review leases to incorporate language that protects the Board.

X. OLD BUSINESS

Mr. Scher asked about the status of the bees.

Dr. Gundersen said that they are safe at an off-campus location and will return in early spring.

Mr. Scher asked about the construction projects including the track.

Dr. Gundersen indicated that projects are complete except for C-Wing air conditioning at Pascack Hills which should be done in a week and a half and the same timeframe for the HVAC for the gyms at both schools. He added that the track is complete.

Ms. Molinelli asked if the senior parking lot will be monitored for mask wearing.

Dr. Gundersen said the senior lot will open up with half the students on a given day. He added that the three SLEOs at each school will be rotating through the lot.

Mr. Blundo heard that the track striping was not completed.

Dr. Gundersen said that he would check on the striping, but the track may be used.

XI. NEW BUSINESS

Ms. Molinelli asked if the administration has looked at southern schools that have been open for 2-3 weeks to see how they are faring.

Dr. Gundersen said he has been in contact with superintendents in the Midwest where their schools have been open since early to mid-August. He is learning from those districts and they have fared well. Dr. Gundersen mentioned that overwhelmingly parents will send their children to our schools. He said 90% of students and 96% of staff will be in-school instruction and six teachers will be teaching remotely. He added that staff have been helped with in-district child care which is at no cost to taxpayers. Dr. Gundersen thanked the board, administrators, secretaries, custodial staff, nurses school physicians, and staff to make this happen.

Mr. Scher would like to inform students, staff and the public that the district has a zero tolerance stance on HIB. He said we should be respectful and understand the expectations on conducting oneself. There should not be a discourse from the norm.

Dr. Gundersen said that the Student Assistance Counselors went over the expectations for HIB reporting procedures with the staff. He stressed that students need to behave correctly.

XII. COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC
