Ms. Molinelli asked about the challenges encountered to school opening and how the district was faring with teachers and substitutes.

Dr. Gundersen indicated that the district has had multiple first days of school. He mentioned that teachers said it was weird, but they were excited to be back in school and seeing the students. He thanked the entire district staff for their work to make this happen. He added his gratitude to the Board for supporting an in-district child care for staff who may have otherwise taken a leave. Dr. Gundersen said the subs are working well with the teachers who are teaching remotely.

Mr. Stankus asked about the status of the wellness check in process.

Dr. Gundersen said there was a technical difficulty today that caused a delay. It was the first full cohort day and the issue has been resolved.

Mr. Blundo added that this occurred 40 minutes prior to the start of class. This caused a lot of anxiety for parents.

Mr. Stankus asked how students not attending in school classes will be treated in regards to sports participation.

Dr. Gundersen said that NJSIAA indicated a start date of September 14 for organized practices and that fully remote learning students may participate.

Mr. Stankus asked if there is a wellness checklist for students when participating in sports.

Dr. Gundersen responded that the athletes would need to meet the wellness requirements.

Ms. Molinelli asked the student reps about their experience on the first day of school.

Aria said it was different, but she is happy to be back. She was excited to see her teachers and as a senior it created a normality.

Connor said it was weird with being six feet apart for social distancing, but happy to be back.

Dr. Gundersen said that all routes with a cost of an aide indicated should have asterisks. He added that transportation logistics have been challenging due to the pandemic. He commended Rose Cangialosi for her work with bus routes in district and he commended Region II and member districts for their work and cooperation with transportation.

Dr. Gundersen reiterated the phenomenal job Ms. Cangialosi has done especially working with Scholastic bus company. He added that the two cohorts create a 50/50 split of students riding the buses.

Mr. Usami added that Rockland Electric has not been cooperative to expedite the process. Dr. Gundersen said that the track at Pascack Valley may be used for track and PE classes. The track needs a final layer of rubber and striping. This should take another couple of weeks, weather dependent.

Ms. Molinelli asked about the bees.

Dr. Gundersen indicated that the bees arrival to Pascack Valley High School has been delayed due to the pandemic. The bees are at an off-campus site and they should arrive in the spring.

Mr. Steinberg asked the students how they are acclimating to in school instruction. Aria responded that in class is better for learning and interacting. She is more comfortable and it's easier to ask questions, to have discussions and to interact with others.

Connor said it's better for the social aspect since he is with other students and not stuck in a room alone. Being in school breaks up the day.
