Superintendent's Report: Mr. P. Erik Gundersen

Good evening and a huge congratulation to our Pascack Valley & Pascack Hills State Sectional Championship baseball teams!!!! Both teams had extra-ordinary seasons and we couldn't be more proud to recognize your accomplishments this evening.

Both high schools experienced successful graduation ceremonies last Thursday. We couldn't have asked for better weather, speeches, and enthusiasm from the members of our community who were in attendance at the event. Thank you to the administration who spearheaded another successful event, our custodial and secretarial members for their supportive efforts, and our video production / technology crew – who were able to video stream the commencements on our website.

The past three weeks have been consumed with the celebrations of our graduation seniors, valedictorian breakfasts, yearbook signings and proms. However, work still continues as we begin to shift our focus to the 2017 – 2018 school year.

Last week I had a meeting with the members of the Pascack Valley clergy group. #### 5. Summer Authorization

**RESOLVED** that the Pascack Valley Regional High School District Board of Education authorize the Superintendent of School to fill existing certificated and noncertificated school vacancies from June 20 – September 8 after consultation with the Board President. Such action is to confirmed at a September 2017 Board of Education meeting.

# 6. Merit Goals for Superintendent

WHEREAS, on or about September 6, 2016, the Pascack Valley Regional High School District Board of Education (hereinafter referred to as the "Board") approved merit bonus goals for the Superintendent for the 2016-2017 school year consisting of three (3) quantitative merit criteria and two (2) qualitative merit criteria and submitted same to the Executive County Superintendent for approval in accordance with N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-3.1(e)10-11 (hereinafter referred to as "Merit Bonus Goals"); and

WHEREAS, on or about October 13, 2016, the Executive County Superintendent approved said Merit Bonus Goals, thereby authorizing the Board to evaluate and award merit bonus increases to the Superintendent upon achievement of each objective; and

- a. WHEREAS, the Board has evaluated the Superintendent's performance and determined that he achieved the objective to improve school community organization relationships by initiating a Community-Advisory Committee that will present information and updates on the PVRHSD to community leaders while seeking input from said community organizations; thereby entitling him to a merit bonus of 3.33% of his annual salary for the amount of \$5,578; and
- b. WHEREAS, the Board has evaluated the Superintendent's performance and determined that he achieved the objective of capitalizing on the district's partnership with the DOE's Future Ready Pledge by initiating all seven "gears" of the Future Ready "Leadership Assessment" to improve student outcomes and guide the district in determining the capacity it has for what is next with regard to its future technology integration plans; thereby entitling him to a merit bonus of 3.33% of his annual salary for the amount of \$5,578; and
- c. WHEREAS, the Board has evaluated the Superintendent's performance and determined that he achieved the objective to proactively communicate to the region constituents the impact that the regional school district has on students and community by initiating three new methods of communicating the message to the four municipalities and its citizens: thereby entitling him to a merit bonus of 3.33% of his annual salary for the amount of \$5,578; and
- d. WHEREAS, the Board has evaluated the Superintendent's performance and determined that he achieved the objective to expand and enhance the scope of high school, student internship opportunities by sharing the student experience at Pascack with additional in-district constituents, companies, organizations, Bergen County school districts, chamber of commerce groups, and other professional organizations; thereby entitling him to a merit bonus of 2.5% of his annual salary for the amount of \$4,187; and
- e. WHEREAS, the Board has evaluated the Superintendent's performance and determined that he achieved the objective to enhance the district's ability to provide student wellness support throughout the year including during the summer months and proposed additional plans to the Board of Education that will allow for improved contact between students / parents and mental health counselors above and beyond prior implementation to promote student social and emotional well-being; thereby entitling him to a merit bonus of 2.5% of his annual salary for the amount of \$4,187; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board hereby approves a non-pensionable merit bonus in the amount of 14.99% for the amount of \$25,108 of the Superintendent's annual salary for the 2016-2017 school year subject to approval by the Executive County Superintendent that the quantitative and qualitative merit criteria for each of the Board assessed objectives has been satisfied for the payment of such merit bonus.

#### XIII. NEW BUSINESS

Mr. Scher attended the last Hillsdale Council meeting. He remarked that Stonybrook Swim Club is going out to bid to enclose the lap pool and wanted to know if it was available for our use. Mr. Gundersen explained that he has been in direct communication and is hoping to take advantage.

Ms. Molinelli congratulated both graduating classes. She said that she was proud to be a part of the district.

Mr. Gundersen commented that he was thrilled to see the amount of board members and faculty in attendance at graduation. The staff rallies around students. Students were respectful and did a wonderful job speaking.

Mr. Blundo remarked that every year Mr. Demaio and Mr. Demarais asked those students who are entering into the military to rise. This year the applause for those students was at a sustained level and was extraordinary.

#### XIV. COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC

Citizens are invited to make comments and are limited to five minutes, according to the Pascack Valley Regional High School District Board of Education policy number 0167. Persons wishing to speak must, upon being recognized, rise and state their name and address.

Mr. Nick Larocca from River Vale addressed the board. He thanked them for their time and commitment. He was there to discuss a proposed policy as a parent of four students from Pascack Valley who were all two-sport varsity athletes. He is a believer in commitment and sacrifice in sports. He received a letter from a former soccer player which talked about policies that are about to be put in place which require students to make a commitment to the team. His concern is that the desire to protect the athletes does not overflow into what we are trying to do academically, particularly with regard to the Italian Honors Society. Punishing students for participating in an honor activity is not a good idea. He asked the board to please address this as a separate issue before voting. Do not punish student athletes. Education first and sports second. Athletes are students first.

Mr. Gundersen explained that he had had a preliminary conversation at a committee meeting. As an administrative team several years ago, the district had tried to broker these issues. Trips are by choice, they are not mandated. Instead of saying the student has to choose, the administrators made an agreement with language arts and athletics so that kids have opportunities. If a student is going on that trip, the coach must prepare his replacement. The student's participation would end an effort to prepare the next student to take his place. Kids can take advantage of both opportunities. The district needs to be respectful of the teams need as well. The system has been working but the district will be discussing and revisiting it again at some point. This is in the very early stages. Any changes will not be imposed for the upcoming school year.

Mr. Novakowsy from Hillsdale addressed the board because he wanted to reiterate what Mr. Larocca had said. The idea of ending a student's season on May 1<sup>st</sup> to prepare another student is ridiculous. He does not agree but respects the board's opinion. A coach threw his son off the team and demanded his jersey back because he decided to attend an Italian honors trip. He was allowed to return after the trip but was forced to sit the bench when he came back. The board needs to decide what the focus of the school is, academics or sports. These are teachers not coaches. The coach was more concerned with his own desire to win than what would happen to the student.

Mr. DeRosa, a parent from Hillsdale, addressed the board. He also had a four-year Italian honor student and a baseball player. He was committed to baseball so he did not go on the trip and missed a great opportunity. Maybe the class could go abroad earlier in the season to mitigate the situation.

Mr. Gundersen explained that it is dependent on the timing of the district in Italy. He also wanted to thank the superintendent for coming to the council meeting.

#### XV. ADJOURNMENT

A motion was made by Ms. Bissinger to adjourn into an executive session at 8:45 p.m. We will not be returning to public session. Ms. Molinelli seconded the motion, which was unanimously carried.
