5. Reject Bids for Phase 2 of the Athletic Field Upgrades Project at Pascack Hills High School

WHEREAS, the Pascack Valley Regional High School District Board of Education ("the Board") advertised for bids for the Phase 2 of the Athletic Field Upgrades Project at Pascack Hills High School ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, on January 31, 2017, the Board received bids for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the bid submitted by the purported low bidder, Rochelle Contracting Company, Inc. ("Rochelle"), is materially defective insofar as the bidder did not list a subcontractor who is properly classified by the Department of the Treasury, Division of Property Management and Construction ("DPMC"), to perform the demolition scope of work for the Project, as well as a DPMC classified steel subcontractor to perform the steel scope of work for the Project, as required by law and the bid specifications, which together are material, nonwaivable defects; and

WHEREAS, the bid submitted by the purported second low bidder, Let it Grow, Inc. ("Let it Grow"), is also materially defective insofar as the bidder did not identify a steel and HVACR subcontractor, as required by the specifications, and did not provide a DPMC 701 form, listing the total amount of uncompleted contracts, as required by law, which together are material, nonwaivable defects; and

WHEREAS, the bid submitted by the purported third low bidder, Applied Landscape Technologies ("Applied Landscape"), is also materially defective insofar as it did not identify a HVACR subcontractor as required by the specifications, and did not identify a plumbing subcontractor who is DPMC classified, as well as provide a DPMC 701 form, listing the total amount of uncompleted contracts, for its Landscape Irrigation subcontractor, as required by law, which together are material, nonwaivable defects; and

WHEREAS, the remaining bids were substantially in excess of the cost estimates for the Project and, as such, are not reasonable as to price on the basis of the cost estimates prepared on behalf of the Board; and

WHEREAS, all bids submitted in response to the advertisement for the Project are non-responsive or substantially exceed the cost estimate of the Project; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The bid submitted by Rochelle, Let it Grow, and Applied Landscaping are hereby rejected for being materially defective.
- 2. The remaining bids are hereby rejected as the bids substantially exceed the costs estimates and, as such, are unreasonable as to price on the basis of the cost estimates prepared on behalf of the Board.
- 3. The Board Secretary/Business Administration is hereby authorized to re-advertise the Project for bids.
