# 1. Overnight Trip

# XI. OLD BUSINESS

Mr. Hallowell gave the Buildings and Grounds report and reported that all open projects have been closed out with the exception of the athletic fields at Pascack Hills which has a scheduled completion date of April 15<sup>th</sup>. The Pascack Valley turf replacement is scheduled for the summer of 2018 and Pascack Hills is scheduled for November of 2018. The music renovation bid will take place at the end of March.

Security enhancements were discussed at the meeting. Enclosing the breezeways and lobbies in both schools is being considered along with enhanced intercom systems and window film installation. Hiring of additional SLEO III officers for after hours will be included in the next year's budget. Video coverage in both schools will be expanded to include all exterior doors. The administration is currently trying to ensure radio coverage in both schools.

Mr. Steinberg commented that the finance committee met and went over the planned budget for the current year. No increase above the 2% cap is expected.

Ms. Bissinger reported that the robotics team went to Waterbury and they made it to the semifinals and will be going to Bridgewater next week.

Mr. Gundersen commented that the research and molecular genetics teams at both schools had banner weekends. They qualified for the ISEF in Pittsburgh.

Mr. Scher added that Ben Vereen was at the performance of Rent.
