## **Juniors and Seniors Honored During Awards Ceremonies**

In May each year, students, families, and community members gather to honor the achievements of Orono High School students. On May 2, we held our annual **Junior and Senior Awards ceremony**. Here are just some highlights from the event:

- 94 juniors were honored for achieving a GPA of 3.5 or higher
- Junior Book Awards were announced for the first time:
  - Dartmouth Book Award, Henry Shafer
  - Harvard Book Award, Quinn Martini
  - St. Lawrence Book Award, Alex Paulsen
  - and Yale Book Award, Ashley Ishaug
- 108 **seniors** were designated Honor Graduates, with 54 already earning one of three AP Scholar honors. Additional graduates will be designated AP Scholars after their final, senior-year exam scores are released this summer.

### **Senior Scholarship Night**

At Senior Scholarship Night held last evening, Dr. Steiner and School Counselor Kayte Haagenson reported that, to date, the Class of 2024 has received more than \$4 million in merit-based scholarships from their colleges, universities, and other outside organizations. Many of these scholarships are based in our community and we are grateful to partner with businesses and families as we support our students. At the event, **\$87,000 in locally raised scholarships** was awarded to 97 different students. Each organization or donor sets clear criteria by which to select the award recipients. I would like to share my immense gratitude to the individuals, families, and organizations who sponsor their own scholarships.

## Henry Shafer: National Student Auditions Semifinalist



### 9th Annual OMS Capstone Showcase


