Scholarship Program 5 Scholarships Available! Guidelines

The Franklin County School Board announces the **2015-16 School Board Scholarship Awards Program**. The purpose of Scholarship Program is to provide scholarships to up to five (5) deserving graduating seniors interested in or intending to pursue post-high school course of study at either college/university or other post-secondary educational institution. Under the Program, five (5)-\$1,000 scholarships will be awarded to seniors. Applicants are eligible to apply for more than one scholarship option, however only one scholarship will be award to the recipient. Children of district employees are eligible to apply.

Available Scholarships:

- Academic (2): \$1,000 scholarships-minimum GPA 3.0**
- Vocational (2): \$1,000 scholarships-minimum GPA 2.5**
- Adversity (1): \$1,000 scholarship-minimum GPA 2.5**

Program Guidelines & Priorities:

- ✓ Seeking graduating seniors with a record of volunteerism in the community in non-school sponsored activities and participation in extracurricular school activities.
- ✓ Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 2.5 to apply for the Vocational and Adversity scholarships and 3.0 for the Academic scholarship (see above) and enroll in a degree-granting program in an accredited school. This applies equally to academic or vocational program.
- ✓ Scholarship awards will be valid until the Fall of the year following high school graduation. Unclaimed awards will revert to the scholarship fund for future disbursement. Payment will be made to student or registrar after verification from the school of the recipient's enrollment.
- ✓ It will be the student's responsibility to submit to the superintendent's office Foundation at that time an invoice for second semester tuition and fees, student ID number and college information.
- ✓ Applicants must have the endorsement of their Guidance Counselor on their application attesting they are a qualified fit for this scholarship program. Application deadline is **Friday May 6, 2016 by 4:00 p.m.**
Late applications will not be accepted.
