- S. 1002.20(3)(d), F.S., K-12 Student and parent rights
 - Each school district shall, on the district's website homepage, notify
 parents of this right and the process to request an exemption. The
 homepage must include a link for a student's parent to access and
 review the instructional materials, as defined in s. 1006.29(2), used
 to teach the curriculum.
- S. 1003.42(1)(b), F.S., Required instruction
 - All instructional materials, as defined in s. 1006.29(2), used to teach reproductive health or any disease, including HIV/AIDS, its symptoms, development, and treatment, as part of the courses referenced in subsection (3), must be annually approved by a district school board in an open, noticed public meeting.
