

## Summer Feeding Program

Please be advised that Harrisburg School District will be sponsoring the Summer Food Service Program. The program provides free nutritious meals to all children ages 1 to 18. Acceptance and participation requirements for the program and all activities are the same for all regardless of race, color, national origin, gender, age or disability, and there will be no discrimination in the course of the meal service. No registration is required if you live in the Harrisburg Area School District. The program will begin on June 15<sup>th</sup> and end on July 31<sup>st</sup>.

Operating Monday through Thursday, this program was established for low income children to receive nutritious meals during the summer vacation period. Harrisburg School District has partnered with the food service management company, The Nutrition Group, to help facilitate this program. There are 21 million eligible children who receive free or reduced meals each year throughout the country but only 3.4 million children receive meals during the summer. There are many hungry children we need to reach! Last summer we fed over 11k breakfasts and 23k lunches.

**Breakfast example:** Assorted cold cereals, assorted hot selection (waffles, pancakes, FT sticks) fresh fruit, 100% fruit juice and ½ pint of fat free milk.

**Lunch example:** Assorted cold sandwiches and wraps, fresh and canned fruit, assorted vegetables and ½ pint of fat free milk.
